Who is good, Is a stronghold, In the day of trouble, A stronghold, In the day of trouble, We sang, We sang, Some of the psalms, And there are many of them, That commend God, To us, As a God, To whom we can, Go, In time, Of trouble, God is our refuge, We were singing, And our strength, In strates, A perfect aid, We know that, We've experienced it, For ourselves, The book of psalms, Is full, Of such, Experiences, That the psalmist, Was able to compose, Out of his experiences, How God, Met with him, How God, Dealt with him, How God, Spoke to him, In his darkest hour, Literally, Every one of us, I suppose, Have understood, What it means, To have somebody, Stand, Alongside us,

Is that not a picture, That is given to us, About Christ, Somebody, Who is an advocate, Somebody, Who is, The intercessor, Somebody, Who stands, Alongside us, When we are, Being challenged, In a court of law, But in the experience, Of the believer, God is saying to us, That he is a stronghold, In the day of trouble, Somebody, Who speaks of himself, As a place of safety, A safe haven, Where the persecuted, Can take refuge, Where those who are, Suffering from the storms, Of life, They can take refuge, And hide, You know, The picture that came, Into my mind is, When you are looking at, See in a winter, Afternoon, And there is a storm, And there is a wind, Blowing, And the rain is lashing down,

And you are inside, And you are looking out, And you are seeing, Some poor person, Who is silent, At sea, Or maybe doing, Something outside, And you are saying to yourself, Well, I am glad, I am in here, I am glad, I am not getting wet, I am glad, I am not cold, I am glad, I am safe, And secure, Where the elements, Can't get to me, But is it not the case, That there is a refuge, In God, That is a spiritual refuge, And those who have, Enjoyed it, And who delight in it, When they see others, Going through, Experiences, That, They might themselves, Might understand, Experientially, And they would say to themselves, Or you would say to yourself, Oh, Is there not a refuge, For them, Is there not a place, Of safety,

To which they can go, And the answer is, Yes, But what can you do, With somebody, Who knows, That there is a refuge, Or who is told, There is a refuge, And who won't use it, Who won't go there, The holy God, Who is infinitely, Removed from his people, By way of holiness, And by way of his, His, Divine attributes, That are incommunicable, Nevertheless, Came into close proximity, To all who are his, In the person of his son, Jesus Christ, And allows us, To avail ourselves, Of the promises, That mark him out, As our refuge, And our strength, We will never attain, To the spiritual, And moral plane, Upon which God, Perpetually resides, But he chose,

To come down, To where we are, And the day, Of trouble, Which is not ever, Far away, From any one of us, He promises, To be a stronghold, Stronghold, Most especially, That is seen, In the gospel, Is it not, What trouble, Is greater, Than the trouble, That sin, Has exposed us to, And yet he invites us, To take refuge, In Christ, And so many, Chose not to, And choose not to, The third, And final thing, We have here, Very briefly, Is this, He knows, In that trust, In him, The knowledge of God, Is as we often, Say, A perfect knowledge, He knows, Everything, That there is, To be known, About all things, Nothing goes on, In this world, Without him, Being aware of him,

Nothing goes on, In your life, Or my life, That he doesn't know, Outwardly, Or, In the depth, Of being, The thoughts, That we have, When you go to your bed, Tonight, There may be a problem, That is concerning you, And you're tossing, And you're turning, And you're alone, And you're afraid, And you're saying, How is this, Going to be resolved, In my life, Did you ever think, At that moment, That God, Was oblivious to you, Sometimes, We persuade ourselves, That very thing, But, He knows, Especially, The knowledge, That this speaks of, Is a knowledge, Of the divine, Electing God, Of his own people, The people, Of his own choice, He knows, Everyone as God, But he knows, His people, As their Lord, And their Redeemer, In the Old Testament,

The words, You know, I was reminded, Of that, As I was preparing, I was reminding it, Of words, Which I often say, To you, That I heard, In prayer, From, The men, That I grew up with, And they would be, Stating these, Sentiments, In prayer, The Lord, The Lord, Knows, Them, That are His, The Lord, Knows, Them, That are His, And that is true, He knows them, With a knowledge, That is, Not just, You know, I think there's something, In the knowledge, That God has, Of, Has of his own, That is, So full, Of, Of compassion, You know, When you're looking, At somebody else's, Child, And that child,

Is in difficulty, You have compassion, To that child, You have, A sense, Of that child's need, But it's nothing, Like the, The sense, That you have, Of that child's need, When that child, Is your own, Or when that child, Is someone, That you know, Personally, There's a, There's a, Power, In the intimacy, That is spoken of, In this statement, Jesus said, To his disciples, What?

I am the good shepherd, He said, I know, My sheep, And to be, The subject, Of that, Divine, And saving, Knowledge, Is not something, That is trivial, It is not something, That is, Not worth, Remembering, Or considering, It's a, Wonderful privilege, The apostle, Paul, In, The second, Book of Timothy, He talks about, The relationship, That exists, Between, God's people, God's servants, And, What they, What they, Sometimes, Have to, Go through, But, He's not ever, So remote,

From them, That what they are going through, Is not, His main concern, Nevertheless, The foundation, Of God, Standeth sure, Having this seal, The Lord, Knoweth them, That are his, And let everyone, That nameth the name, Of Christ, Depart from iniquity, But in a great house, There are not, Only vessels of gold, And of silver, But also of wood, And of earth, Some to honour, Some to dishonour, If a man, Therefore, Purge himself, From these, He shall be a vessel, And to honour, Sanctified, And meet, For the master's use, And prepared, And do every, Good work, And then, Begins that, Statement, Let everyone, Who knows the name, Of the Lord, Depart, From iniquity, He knows them, They know him, And by virtue,

Of that knowledge, That is theirs, They behave accordingly, When we read these words, Of prophecy, When we read these words, That, You know, You notice, I'm sure, The concluding, Passage, Of the first chapter, Behold upon the mountains, The feet of him, That bringeth good tidings, That publisheth peace, Amazing, In the midst of a, A book, That is concerned, With desperate wickedness, In the world, And God's judgment, Upon that world, And those who are, In it, In the midst of it all, He brings words, Of comfort, And consolation, And he brings, The certain promise, Of a saviour,

To a fallen, And a sinful world, God is good, God is, A God, Who is a, Refuge, In our troubles, God is a God, Who, Knows, The needs of those, Who, Have placed their trust in him, Are you one of them, Are you one of them, Would you not, Would you not, Would you be better, To be one of them, If you are not, God encourage you, To look to him, To us, As we sang, To begin with, The refuge, And the strength, Of his people, Let us pray, Oh Lord, Oh God, We give thanks, For the awesome, Nature of, Of your world, That brings us, Face to face, With the realities, Of who you are, To your people, What you mean to them, And what you, Are for them, In their time of need, And that even though,
