and be not conformed to this world but then you transform by the renewing of your mind that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God how can we please God? first it is a new way of living God says present your bodies to him, a living sacrifice I beset you therefore brethren by the mercies of God and the people who are in the world are in the world Paul challenges us to present your bodies to God it starts with God's grace it is because of his great love that he gives to us this world does not know God the world says if it feels good do it the world does not care about God but the Lord wants the best for your life for you to choose the best way to live and God's grace and goodness leads us to make a decision we can decide to give our life to God to dedicate yourself to God like a living sacrifice

God says to us place yourself on the altar to give yourself at his disposal for him to use you and when it says present your bodies it means all of who you are to want your life to be for God's use and when it says present your bodies there was a man called William Booth who founded the Salvation Army and one day they asked him why his ministry was so successful and he said God has had all there was of me to have he didn't hold anything back he gave everything to God what about you are you ready to be a living sacrifice amen give him your life like a sacrifice hold nothing back give him your life to please him not yourself give him your life to please him not yourself it's a new way of living a new life to be a living sacrifice to be a living sacrifice hallelujah

To please God means to be like Enoch.

It says of Enoch in Hebrews 11 verse 5, By faith Enoch had this testimony that he pleased God. We can ask God, How can I please you God?

For you are bought with a price. Therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit which are God's.

[13:54] He has bought you with a precious price, the precious blood of Jesus.

You belong to God now. So we sacrifice what we want and do what God wants with our life.

And when we do what God wants it's always the best, the very best.

When we truly are living sacrifice we want always to give God the glory.

It's empty. To look up to the idols of this world. The idols the world worships.

No, we must follow Jesus instead. This world and the people of this world have no hope.

But we have living hope. We have eternal hope. Amen. And our lives are full of Jesus and for his glory.
