[14:29] When people are afraid of heights And of dangers in the streets When the almond tree blossoms And a grasshopper Drags itself along And desire no longer is stirred Then people go to the eternal home And mourners go about the streets Remember him Before the silver cord is severed And the golden ball is broken So this is talking about how in the end everything is broken And our bodies deteriorate And ultimately return to the soil In verse 12

In chapter 12:1-8 Solomon points out two things The first thing is The best thing in life is to be able to walk with God serve God and remember God And the most frightening thing in life was old age death And because by then you cannot do anything That is why he tells young people that While they are still fit And have not grown old To enjoy the joys of walking with God

Maybe today Some of you are touched And want to serve God more But although you may have this kind of feeling You are waiting Why are you waiting Because you're too busy working Too busy with school Or too busy doing other things But and also Some people want to read The Bible more Pray more And draw closer to God But they're always delaying it Why are you delaying it Is it only when you retire And you cannot even walk That you would then go serve God

Is it when you cannot even see clearly And then you will go read the Bible In the New Testament There was a girl called Mary Who offered her most precious bottle of perfume To Jesus To wash His feet Maria When the other disciples saw what she was doing They were all complaining about what she was doing and how expensive that perfume was But instead Jesus' reply Was that what the girl was doing Was a wonderful thing

It was not a wonderful thing Simply because of how expensive The perfume was But it was because What the girl was doing Was in the right time Because Jesus was soon to be put on the cross and die And while this young girl could still see Jesus face to face She took this opportunity to offer her best to God So Today What is your most precious thing that you have Think about What is the most precious thing you have right now

So in the from the last talk and today we can see that Solomon's views on life can be put into two groups. The first part is how people should live in society in order to be wise people. So you need to have healthy relationships.

[25 : 45] Think before you act to be careful of your language and to have positive encouragement in your language and it's very important to have a good leader among people and number seven talks about how we can pursue dreams and things in our lives but don't be over the top and don't cross the line that God has given us in life we need to understand about investments or doing good deeds so it's talking about how God has blessed us each with different talents and abilities and we should not just keep this to ourselves but actually share it to other people so you don't put all your eggs in one basket and to know your limits and if you don't know you know your limit then you become proud and arrogant card so these are the wisdom that you need to be able to live in a human society the first one is to be accountable for your own actions and also to remember God whilst you were young and the third one is to fear God and keep his commandments

Jesus said that he came into this world not to make the old testament laws obsolete but to complete them Jesus has already summarized all of the of what Solomon had learned and all the laws of the old testament into two commandments
