[18 : 21] When we do not repent, we are not admitting that we require God's grace, and hence we do not receive God's grace.

And if this is the case, our worship becomes meaningless, and it does not have something. Today, when we come to work with God, have we brought our heart over pumpkins?

In Luke 17, it records one instance of a feeling done by Jesus.

As Jesus was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him, and they stood in a distance, and cried out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us."

When Jesus saw them, He said, "Go and show yourselves to the priests, and they went, and they were attorneys."

[19 : 52] One of them, when he saw he was healed, turned back, praising God in a loud voice.

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I believe every single one of us here have received many of God's blessings in many areas of that.

Just like the leper who was healed. Or are we lost the other nine who were healed?
