The Bible repeatedly emphasizes on the concept of being different. which is to say that Christians have to be separated from the world. And they have to be different from non-Christians.

In 2 Corinthians 6 verses 14 to

18 It says Do not be yoked together with unbelievers for what do righteousness and weakness have in common Or what fellowship can light have with darkness. What harmony is there between Christ and Belial which is Satan And what does a believer have in common with an unbeliever.

What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols For we are the temple of the living God As God has said I will live with them and walk among them And I will be their God And they will be my people. Therefore come out from them And be separate Be separate Says the Lord Touch no unclean thing And I will receive you. I will be a father to you And you will be my sons and daughters Says the Lord Almighty. The above passage reiterates the concept of being separate. It's to tell us that Christians should be separated Amongst non-Christians.

So what are the differences between Christians and non-Christians. In today's scripture reading First John chapter 2 Verses 3 to 4 It says We know that we have come to know him If we obey his commands The man who says I know him But does not Oh sorry. The man who says I know him But does not do what he commands Is a liar And the truth is not in him. It can be seen that Christians Come to know Jesus By obeying his commands. The truth is not with those that do not do what he commands.

And they will not And they also will not get to know Christ. And if they call themselves Christians And they are lying And this is the difference between Christians and non-Christians. So how can you become a true Christian. In verse 5 it says But if anyone obeys this word God's love is truly made complete in him This is how we know we are in him Yohan. John says By obeying God's words We are expressing our love to him. And by doing so We know that we belong to him.

[10 : 12] In verse 6 it says Whoever claims to live in him Must walk as Jesus did. This is to say All who claim to live in him And claim to be Christians Must walk as Jesus did. This is once again It's to say that if you're a Christian Then you should aim to imitate Jesus. And to let Jesus be your example When you're living in this world. And let others say Christ's image through you. So how can we live out Christ's image.

Today we can examine The scriptures written by John, Paul and Peter To see examples of Christ's humility, love and sufferings To help us live out Christ's characteristics and to be a true Christian Let us first examine Examples of Christ's humility As written by John 13:3-10 In the book of John Chapter 13 Verses 3 to

10 Jesus knew that the father had put all things under his power And that he had He had come from God And was returning to God So he got up from the meal Took off his outer clothing And wrapped a towel around his waist

After that he poured water into a basin And began to wash His disciples' feet Drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him Lun He came to Simon Peter Who said to him Lord are you going to wash my feet Yesu Jesus replied You do not realize What I am doing But later you will understand No said Peter You shall never wash my feet Jesus answered Unless I wash you You have no part with me Then Lord Simon Peter replied Not just my feet But my hands and my head as well 13:15

In verses 13 to 15 It says You call me teacher and lord And rightly so For I am what I am Now that I Your lord and teacher have washed your feet You also wash one another's You also should wash I have set an example that you should do as I have done for you
