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Hallelujah! Hallelujah! All right, how many of you are looking forward to today's message? Some of you are wondering if it is a type of Indian cuisine or Mediterranean dish or a type of a new gadget.

[1:34] What kind of message is this? All right. When you read the Bible. If you read the Bible. Thank you, Jesus.

If you read the Bible and you do not see Christ, you haven't read it. So I said it.

I put it this way some time ago. When you read the Bible, put on your sunglasses. Not S-U-N glasses.

But S-O-N. S-O-N glasses. You know, years ago I watched a certain movie. I think it's called National Treasure or something like that.

Steve Cage or something. Nicholas Cage, rather. And you know, when there's a particular paper or graph they were supposed to be reading.

Or map. It's a map. They're supposed to be reading. But some things are coded in it. Freemasons have coded something. So you can't see it with your naked eye. There's a special type of glass you have to wear.

And go somewhere and take a special type of covering lens on the glass. And then wear it. And then you'll be able to read the map. So if you.

Oh, how many of you have watched? I've seen that movie. Yeah. If you just look at the map, you'll be missing. You'll think, oh. No. But behind the map is. Or within behind the map are other coded and coded drawings.

Hidden and veiled. You will never see it with your naked eyes. Unless you put on that special mazenic lens. That will let you see what this map is saying.

Where to move. In the same way. If you read the Bible without the sun, S-O-N, Christ glasses. You won't see squat. It's just a mental exercise.

[3 : 42] A mental exercise. Not a spiritual exercise. The Bible is not meant for our minds. It's meant for our hearts.

Yes. Yes. Yes. Yes. Yes. The Bible on your mind can't change you. It's the Bible in your heart that changes you and renews your mind. And illuminates your mind.

Such that. That's why Ephesians talks about by the renewal. Sorry. I pray that the eyes of your understanding. All right. The eyes of your understanding being enlightened.

Other translation puts the eyes of your heart. Your mind is an aspect of your heart. So until you are born again, your mind cannot be illuminated to see the things of God.

So this is how Jesus puts it. In Matthew chapter 13, I think verse 11 or so, he says that to you the mysteries of the kingdom are given.

[4:45] All right. He answered and said, because it has been given to you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven. But to them, it has not been given. Some people can't know the mysteries.

So can you imagine if you can't know the mysteries? It's not been given to you to know the mysteries. And you go and take the Bible and you are trying to do theology to really understand. People say, I've read the Bible.

I've read the Quran. And I've made comparison. Listen, listen, listen. To you, it's mysteries. You can't know. So you'll be making all that noise. Blah, bla

Jesus said, you are not knowing the scriptures. Not knowing the, in fact, he said, he, in Revelation chapter 2, verse 7 or so, he said, he who has ears, let him hear what the church, what the spirit says to the churches, not to the masses.

God's business is not to reveal things for people outside the church. So long as God is concerned, the little common sense he has given them should tell them there is God. Because in Romans chapter 1, it says that all his invisible attributes are clearly seen, Romans 1, 18 and 19, being understood by the things that are made.

[6:01] So if you look at the things that are made alone, it points to God intentionally programming himself, understanding or revelation of himself.

It says that, for since the creation of the world, he's talking about God's, his invisible attributes are clearly seen. It's not ambiguously seen or portrayed.

Clearly seen. So the things that you see are actually reflective of God's invisible attributes. It's, it's packaged in creation.

So they are clearly seen, what? Being understood by the things that are made. Even his eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse. You can't say that I don't know God exists. You can't say, when you look at your shoe, it points you to the fact that there must be a creator.

There must be someone who makes stuff. A shoe, a bomb can fall in place and then shoes, nice dresses and a big bang can create order. There's never any time where something order, organized system comes out of a bang.

[7:08] All right. So when you read the Bible and you don't put on the sunglasses, you will not see squat.

Because in John chapter 5, verse 39, Jesus said that you search through the scriptures. Thinking that in them, let's go.

Let's read the other, let's go. For in them, you think you have eternal life. And these are they which testify. What do the scriptures do?

Testify. What do the scriptures do? Testify. At the time when he said you search through the scriptures, he was talking about the Old Testament.

Because the New Testament was written after his death, burial and resurrection. After the church was born. So he called the Old Testament scriptures. One.

And he says that you search through the scriptures and the Old Testament are talking about me. So if you read the Old Testament and you don't see Jesus, you haven't actually read it.

These are scribes and Pharisees, doctors of the law, teachers of the people. They have been trained for most of their lives. They understood the law and the text of the writings.

They do research. They are specialist researchers in the scripture. But they said, thinking that you are looking, thinking that you find eternal life. Where is it? And the thing is talking about me.

And I've come to me. I've come. And yet, you are looking for eternal life. And the scripture is always talking about. The eternal life the scripture is talking about is me. And now I've come to you.

Richard, he says, testify of me. Go to the next verse. Verse 40. But you are not willing to come to me that you may have life. The scripture is pointing. So you are going to Birmingham. And the sign is saying M1.

[9:10] M1. And you are not willing to go on the M1. How can you get to Birmingham? If that's the only route. Or, you know, when your sad nap tells you, turn right.

You keep ignoring. You give it another chance. Give it another chance. So, the sad nap is, you say you want to be guided. He's guiding you. Oh, he's guiding you. Or guiding.

Guiding you. He's guiding you. And you are actually not complying with it. Because you are not interested in what the sad nap is telling you. And you are claiming this sad nap. Sad nap is not working. Why?

He said the scriptures are pointing. So, when you read the scriptures. Now, when he resurrected from the scriptures. Sorry. From the dead. On the road to Emmaus. In Luke chapter 24.

Somewhere from verse 20, 21, 22. Bible says that he. I think 25, 26. Now, the Bible says. And from Moses. He began to explain to them.

[10:10] All that was written concerning him. Verse 27. And beginning at Moses. Let's say beginning at Moses. Beginning at Moses. And all the prophets. He expounded to them.

In all the scriptures. The things concerning him. So, beginning at Moses. And all the prophets. He expounded to them. From the scriptures.

He expounded. He expounded to them. In all the scriptures. Or. Even the words. There. You. Come. The words.

Words. The letters. Were all pointing to Christ. If you don't wear the sunglasses. You won't find it. And so. From Moses. Moses epitomized.

Or pointed to Christ. In a certain way. Now. When you read. The book of Romans. Chapter 5. Verse 14. This is a very important text. So, I want us all to read it together.

[11:06] Romans. Chapter 5. Verse 14. Are you ready to read it out? Please. Let's go. Let's read it out loud. Nevertheless.

Death reigned from Adam to Moses. Even over those who had not sinned. According to the likeness of the transgressions of Adam. Who is a type of him who was to come.

What was Adam? A type of him. I can't hear you. A type of him who was to come. Who is the him who was to come talking about? Him. Him is capital.

So, Adam was a type. When you read the King James. He said he was a figure. The Greek word translated. It sounds like. Like. Tupos. T-U-P-O-S or so.

Tupos. It's like. A figure. It's a manner. Like manner. Manner. Sorry. It's like. An example. So, when you see the word type.

Okay. Give us the amplifier. Let's see how you push it. It says that. Yeah. That. Okay. Adam. Who was the type? A prefigure. That was a prefigure.

Something that is figuring something that is supposed to be coming afterwards. So, pre. Showing this out is going to be like. You know. What's the code? When. When you go to the bank or some shop.

They have sample types of money. Samples. No. Specimen. So, it's like. The government is about to release 100 pound notes. And then it shows a specimen.

It's not the original. Right. All right. So, you. Everything about 100 pound notes. The size and everything. You can tell from the specimen. So, Adam. Was a type of Christ who is coming.

So, there are ways you should look. You can look at Adam. And there is reflection of Christ within Adam. When you look at Adam. You should be able to see Christ. Into a certain extent.

[12:57] Not in the sinning. But in what way. The way one man sinned against God. And all of us were plunged into sin. Without having to sin. Whether you sinned or not.

You became a sinner. Because of Adam. In the same way. Another type of Adam came. Where you don't have to do anything good first. When you come into him. God sees you as righteous.

So, if. That's Romans chapter 5. It says that. Look at verse 19. If by one man's sin. For if by one man's disobedience.

Many were made sinners. So, also by one man's. See that man. The second man is. Christ. By one man's obedience. Many will be made righteous.

So, you are not made righteous. In the sight of God. Because of your obedience. But because of his obedience. And when you come into him. His obedience covers you.

[13:53] Amen. That's the Christian story. The Christian message is not about. Do good. And God will accept you. It is about. Come in Christ. And God will accept you in Christ.

And empower you to live the way you want to live. You should live. That's the Christian message. So, in Christianity. Justification goes before sanctification.

In other religions. You have to sanctify yourself. Behave well. Before you can be justified. Christianity. You will be justified. And empowered to behave well.

In Christianity. In Christianity. In Christianity. Watch this. Watch this. Watch this. I have so much to say. In Christianity. Duty.

Does not go. Before. Doctrine. Doctrine. Goes before duty.

[14:49] In Christianity. Salvation. Goes before works. In other religions. Works go before salvation. God saves you first.

Before he expects you to behave a certain way. Patricia. Are you getting it? God saves you first. Before he expects you to. That's why when we go preaching. Some people say.

I can't stop this. You know. When you talk about Christianity. The first. That's what the organized religion. Has made Christianity look like. So, when you mention Christ. They are thinking about laws. Ten commandments.

What's God's going to tell you? It's Christ. All the commandments are summed up in Christ. When you are in Christ. He has met all the commandments. Which you can't meet. And he gives you his righteousness.

He slaps it on you. So, that is how. In the way. Adam is like Christ. Adam is not actually mine. Adam is like Christ. And not only Adam. Bible talks about Abel.

[15:46] Abel. Even though he's dead. Yet he speaks. His blood is speaking. Who else's blood has been speaking in the Bible? We know. It's the blood of Jesus. The only difference is that. Jesus Christ speaks better things.

Than that of Abel. So, in a certain sense. Abel was like Christ. In what sense? He was murdered by a brother. He was. He was. Fraudless.

He hadn't done anything wrong. Jealousy. And hatred. Made them kill him. Made him kill him. In the same way. Jesus was innocent. But he was killed. And the innocent blood always spoke.

So, Abel's blood's blood is speaking. And Jesus' blood also speaks. To the extent that. In the New Testament. The only one the Bible actually calls. Use the word righteous for. Is Abel.

In Matthew chapter 23. I think verse 33. 34 somewhere. He said. From the blood of righteous Abel. And the only one the Bible has called. In the New Testament righteous.

[16:43] Is Christ. The righteous one. The just one. Some translations use just. Other translations use. The blood of righteous Abel. And he said. You demanded. The hymn.

I think Acts chapter 2. Pontius Palate. To give. Either Acts chapter 2. Verse 20. That was. Acts chapter 4. 20. That was. 24. That was somewhere there. No. It's 20. Acts chapter 2. Verse 23.

24. Somewhere there. When Pilate wanted to put. Acts chapter 2. Verse 24. No. 20. Let's go to 21. From 21.

I said. And come to pass. Cause the name of Lord Jesus. I said. 22. 22. Israel. This was. The miracle. All right. 23. It talks about lawless hands.

And you put to death. Yeah. Go ahead. The next. And then you. It's not possible. Okay. That's not the one. It's the way. It spoke about. You. I think chapter 24. Possibly. Acts chapter 4.

[17:38] And it's not part of my main text. So. Where it says that. You. You exchange. The righteous one. For a lawless man. You demanded Pilate.

To give him. Give you the lawless one. In exchange. For the righteous one. So Jesus was. Is called in scriptures. The righteous one. Abel. Is called in scripture. The righteous one.

So Abel. Is a type of Christ. When I say type. I hope you understand that. He. He. Prefigures Christ. He. He. Typifies. That's the actual. Theological way.

He. Is a type of him. So. He typifies him. You can look at Abel. And be able to tell. Another. One in the bible. Who typifies Christ. Is Noah. I spoke about Noah.

How it took Noah. For the. To bring us through. The waters. Into a new land. Noah. Was the way. Another one who typifies Christ. I like this one. I know. I know you too. You like him. It's Isaac.

[18:33] In what way? The only son of his father. Who was given as a sacrifice. But on that mountain. He wasn't the one who died. It was the lamb of God who died. On that mountain. Of God.

When Jesus was died. He was crucified. But he didn't die as the son of God. He died as the lamb of God. Amen. Amen. Amen. Isaac. Isaac. Was the only begotten of his father.

The only son he loved. Jesus Christ. So Isaac typified Christ. But then it brings me to. One of the. Moses also typified Christ. David. And there are different ones. And one of the big ones is the tabernacle.

Or the lamb for the Passover. These are all. Figures of Christ. But the major one. That I want to talk about this morning. Is Joseph. Joseph.

Someone say Joseph. Joseph. Joseph. In what way did Joseph look like Christ? In what way? Several ways. I can give you about 12. I have written here.

[19:28] About 12 different ways. But because of my time. I have to end up on the main one. So I won't elaborate on any of them. But I will just mention it. For those of you. Who are familiar with text of scripture.

You may know. In the first time. First of all. Joseph was a shepherd. Genesis 37. Verse 2. Joseph was a shepherd. And you know Jesus is a shepherd.

John chapter 10. He said I am the good shepherd. John chapter 10. From his 11. Verse 1. John 10. 11. What does he say? Okay. It's on the screen. It says that. I am the what? So Joseph was a shepherd.

Jesus was a shepherd. Hallelujah. And he was the beloved of his father. Genesis 37. Verse 3 and 4.

His father loved him. How about Jesus? He said this is my beloved son. In Matthew chapter 3. Verse 17. And Matthew chapter 17. Verse 5. A voice came from heaven. Matthew 3.

[20:24] 17. A voice came from heaven. And he said this is my beloved son. In whom I am worth. So Joseph was the beloved of his father. Jesus was the beloved of his father. How about this?

Joseph was sent by his father. To go and give food to his brothers. Hmm. Does that look like Jesus? Jesus was sent by God. John chapter 6.

Verse 38. Jesus was sent. In fact. It talks about how he came to his own. By his own did not receive. For I have come down from heaven. Not to do my will. But to do the will of he who sent me.

He was sent to his brothers. Jesus was sent to his brothers. Just as Joseph was sent to his brothers. Or let me put it this way. Joseph was sent to his brothers. Just as Jesus will be sent to his brothers.

Hallelujah. Hallelujah. And in several ways. Number 4 or 5. Oh. Number 4. You can't wait to hear this. His brothers hated him. Persecuted and betrayed him.

[21:24] Hmm. And what way did they betray him? Didn't they sell him? His brothers hated him. They persecuted him. Bible says in Genesis chapter 33. Sorry. 37.

That they hated him the more. Hehehehe. Genesis chapter 33 verse 5. And then verse 18. When they. 37 I'm sorry.

Not 33. 37. When they saw him come. They said there comes the dreamer. They conspired. They conspired to get rid of him. Oh. In my Bible studies. Pastor Charles. You know what I found out.

Are you ready for this? I just want to chip this in. Yes. Because I don't think I'll have the chance to ever come back to this text. I found out. That Genesis chapter 37.

Look at verse 28. 27 to 28. Okay. Let's go to 27. Look at this. Come. Let us sell him to the Ishmaelites. That's talking about his brother.

[22:19] Their brother Joseph. Come. Let us sell him. And let not our hands be. Let's not kill him. Let's rather sell him. For he is our brother and our flesh. He was sent to his brothers.

It was his brothers. Listen. The most painful thing is for your brother to sell you. Not your neighbors. But your brothers. The same blood.

You grew up with. They sold him. And it wasn't like they even dragged him. And he was unconscious. He was begging them. Please. Don't do this. Please.

Don't do this. They said take him. You know who they sold to. Who is Ishmael? Ishmael. Ishmael.

According to Genesis chapter 16 verse 15. Hey. I feel like preaching. So Hagar bore Abraham a son. And Abraham named him the son who Hagar bore Ishmael.

[23:20] The son of the flesh. The son of the flesh. The son of the flesh. The son of the child of promise. The beloved child to the sons of the flesh.

Be careful as you sell your pastor. Be careful. The things you say about your pastor. Be careful. You may be selling a Joseph to Ishmaelites.

Because of the convenience of your flesh and your feelings. Oh. I haven't finished what I was reading. Go. Genesis chapter 27. Look at 28.

It said. It said. Then the Midianites. Traders passed by. So the brothers pulled Jacob up. And lifted him out from the pit.

And sold him to the Ishmaelites. For 20 shekels of silver. The Midianites. Who are the Midianites? Oh. No.

[24:18] We have to find. Who is Midian? Midian. You know you like the Midianites? Yes. You always talk about the Midianites. Genesis chapter 25. Some of you have never seen this before. I wish me too.

I was sitting in a congregation. Listen. Oh. I said Genesis 25. Which was that? Verse 1 and 2. Let's already. Oh my.

Thank you Jesus. Genesis 25. Verse 1 and 2. Let's go. Hey. Abraham. It's not only Sarah. He got another wife.

Those of you who think his only child was Isaac. No. After 99. When the word of God hit his body. After Sarah had a child.

He said who's next? He wants to try me. I will show you that now. God has visited me. I got the power. See. Verse 2.

[25:22] Verse 2. Keturah. And she bore him Zimram, Jokshan, Medan, Midian. Abraham had other one, two, three, four, five, six.

From the woman, go back verse one. From the woman, he took us the wife Keturah. Kate, Kate.

Kate, Kate. Kate. But isn't it interesting, some of you never knew that Abraham had other children.

And guess what? They sold Jacob, sorry, Joseph to the Ishmaelites, Medianites and Ishmaelites.

The people of the flesh. And guess what they did to him? They took him. Hey! Oh, I feel like preaching. They, I've not even gotten to Zaphana. Zaphana.

[26:31] They took him to Egypt. Egypt was a type of the world. The flesh will send you into Egypt.

You fiery sister, fiery brother, you have been, you are successfully betrayed and sold your spiritual stance because of offense, your feeling, your fleshly desire.

Me, I don't care. And you have ended up so worldly, you have become like Saul of Tarsus fighting the church. you are not in the world.

Egypt is in scripture. Anytime you see Egypt is a type of the world. Egypt. Don't go down to Egypt. Don't go into Egypt. Anyway, so they sold him.

Jesus too was betrayed by his brothers and he was sold. Didn't you know Jesus was sold? Yes. No, no, no, no, no, no, no, no, no, no. Matthew chapter 27 verse, verse, verse 9.

Yes. Oh, 27, yeah. Verse 9. No, verse 50. No. Matthew 27 verse 50 something. Is it verse 9? And then Jerusalem took 30.

Yeah, 30 pieces of silver. Yeah, it's 50. And the value of him, that's the soul of Jesus Christ. Actually, when you read 26 verse 15. 26 verse 15. Thank God for the remembering, giving me the memory.

What are you willing to give me? That's Judas negotiating for Jesus. What are you willing to give me if I deliver him to you? And they counted 30 pieces of silver. Joseph was sold for 20 pieces of silver.

Jesus was sold. Who was sold? His own trusted people. His own trusted people. You see how Joseph was very much like Jesus? Yes. He's a major type of Jesus.

Hallelujah. Yes. Should I continue? Yes. And number five, he was cast into prison.

[28:32] Joseph was cast into prison. But Jesus' own was not just prison. It was death. The prison of death. What was very funny about Jesus' death was Joseph's prison.

How many of you remember what kind of prison he was? The prison Joseph was put in, they put him in the prison where the king's criminals were kept. And we don't know how many criminals were there, but definitely, Joanna, we knew there were two.

One was released back, restored into glory. The other one was executed. Jesus Christ on the cross, he was condemned with two criminals.

One was released into glory. The other one was condemned. Joseph, very much like Christ because of time. Number six.

What I like was Joseph did not stay permanently in prison. Genesis chapter 41 verse 14. Bible says that the king sent for him. They told him, come.

[29:47] Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph and they brought him quickly out of what the dungeon, not just a prison, no, dungeon. And he shaved, when you are going for interview, please shave.

Change, change your clothes before you come before Pharaoh, okay? Don't say it's God who is hiring. God is the one who opens the door. God is the one who opens the door, so it doesn't matter how I look.

No. Men look on the outside. So some of, some of you men or some of you ladies, possibly no one has showed interest because of the way you dress.

I'm not saying people show interest just because of that, but possibly, at least, somebody to like something nice. Don't say, ask for me, it doesn't matter what, wherever, God has given to me, he'll give to me.

And your wig is here, and then natural hair is growing like, buffalo, buffalo, buffalo, buffalo, buffalo, soldier.

[31:02] All right, all right. Zephaniah, panier. Ah, I have to finish this thing. I guess I have to do that talk. So, but, Jesus didn't stay in the dungeon. Sorry, Joseph didn't, the king sent out for him.

How about Jesus? When they crucified him and buried him, three days later, he resurrected. Acts chapter 2, verse 24. I like that one. Hey! I think it would be nice if we all read it from the screen.

Is that okay? Is that okay? Yes. Or say it don't. Let's all read. Let's go. It wasn't possible that Joseph should stay in prison.

Time, maybe tomorrow I'll continue a few stuff about Joseph, but today I have to deliver the zephaniah. All right. Joseph, what did God wait for?

When he was sold, when he was a young man around 17 years, and he went into Egypt, stayed in prison, someone who God was going to make a race to become a prominent person.

[32:12] Why did it take God over, it was 30 years before God promoted him. Did you have to stay in the prison for all this while? Sis, you may have to.

You may have to. God is still working on you. God is still working on you. Amen. The fact that you arrive, church people are getting testimony doesn't mean everything changes immediately for you. God is working on you.

And sometimes you need to be prepared for your lifting. You need it. Some of us are going through certain financial training because of the financial wealth God is about to bring you into.

Paul said, I have learned how to abase and how to abound. God will teach you both the ups and the downs. So that in whatever state you are, Paul said, I am content.

Philippians chapter 4, verse 13, 14, 12, 13, and 14, somewhere there. So God, God, God will teach you. He will take you.

But the problem is that most of us abort the training program. Abort the training. Maybe the reason why you are not married is God is packaging you to be a wonderful wife.

You have to go through some things to testarize you and prepare you because you are about to give birth to someone who will become a major wealth figure. So God is taking you through the...

God waited. And secondly, Joseph had to be 30 because Jesus started his ministry at 30. So if he had been released from prison earlier, it was premature.

And secondly, thirdly, the priest, in those times, the priest to become, to enter into the office of a full priest, you must be 30. An apprentice, 25.

Soldier, 20. But priest, 30 and over. So Joseph couldn't just... He had to stay in prison from portifers' house. He went down to the dungeon, stayed there, was interpreting people's dreams, and yet his own was uninterpreted.

[34:17] Bible says in Psalm 105 that when the time came, I think Psalm 105 verse 19. Psalm 105 verse 19 talks about...

I like that text. That's it. Until the time his word came to pass, the word of the Lord tested him. Verse 20. And the king sent and released him.

The ruler of the people let him free. But before then, they bound his feet with fetters. In fact, now, 17 and 18 said they hurt his feet. Ah, is that all the process of greatness?

Look at this. 18, 18. 17 before 18. 17. He sent a man before them. What did he do? Oh, I can't hear you. What did he do? He sent a man before them.

Ah, but they sold him. No. They were selling him, but God was sending him. It wasn't they who sent him, who sold him. They did sell with malicious intentions, but their malicious intentions were part of the program of God.

[35:21] He, God, sent a man before them, Joseph, who was sold as a slave. Look at the next verse. They hurt his feet. God, why do you have to do this to me?

God, they are hurting me. God, they are hurting me. God says, it's still the process. They can't kill you. They may hurt you, but they can't abort your destiny, and they can't kill you. Because whatever the case, you are going to end up on the throne.

Is there one year, your feet is being hurt? You are going through things. Your feet is being hurt. Don't stop the process. Keep looking at God.

There's so much I can say about Joseph. How his brothers, his brothers, one of his brothers called, not Reuben, Simon, went and, no, no, actually Judah.

Judah. In Genesis chapter 38, verse 15, Judah. Judah. Look at what Judah do. And Judah saw her and thought she was a harlot because she had covered herself, and Judah went and slept with the woman.

[36:33] They couldn't control their passions and their anger. Joseph, in the next chapter, verse 12, Potiphar's sophisticated wife gave him an offer. She caught him by his garment saying, lie with me.

Please, come and have a feel of me, Joseph. And what did Joseph do? But he left his garment in her hands and fled and ran outside. His brothers were falling to their sexual and internal desires, pressure.

he was able to run away from it. His brothers had emotional issues. They hated him, couldn't control their emotions and got rid of him. Him, when his brothers show up, he remember what they have done to him.

The Bible said he held himself back and he covered himself. He didn't show himself just so that God's plan can be fulfilled. Amen. I believe God is raising a Joseph here. I believe God is raising a Joseph here.

Hey! I love you rationing this thing. So, maybe I'll continue in what ways he's like Christ. Alright, I won't give you the text. Maybe I'll throw a bit more light on it during the week.

[37:41] But, um, okay, so he was, Jesus was raised from the dead. Seven, he was enthroned into authority.

Joseph was enthroned into authority. How about Jesus? Bible says God has given him, he said, it came in Matthew chapter 28 verse 18, all authority in heaven and on earth is given to me. Therefore, go into the world and make disciples.

In Acts chapter 2 verse 36, he says that God exalted him. Acts 2 verse 36, I like that one. He said, therefore, let all the house of Israel know and, know assuredly that God has made this Jesus whom you crucify, both Lord and Christ.

God exalted him. Joseph was exalted, was promoted. Eight, in, in receiving, uh, he, he, he, I like this.

This, this is where my message is coming up. Genesis chapter 40, 41. Let's look.

Okay, I think now we are going to read. Let's look into our Bibles. God, this is where, if your Bible is yours, I'd like to underline because I'm about to end the message. Genesis chapter what?

41 verse what? I didn't tell you the verse. All right. All right. Thank you, Jesus. Thank you. I, I, I, I, let me just tell you from verse 30.

So, the advice was good in the eyes of Pharaoh and the eyes of all his servants and, uh, and Pharaoh said unto his servants, can we find such a man as this?

A man in whom is the spirit of God? And Pharaoh said to Joseph, in as much as God has shown you all this, all this, there is no one as discerning and wise as you.

You, you shall be over my house. That's the promotion. You shall be over my house and all my people shall be ruled according to your word. Only in regards to the throne will I be greater than you.

Don't forget what I just said. Only in regards to the throne will I be greater than you. You can put you on the screen, that's fine. Only in regards to the throne will I be greater than you. Verse 42 from your Bibles, and, and Pharaoh said to Joseph, see, I have set you over all the land of Egypt.

Jesus said, all power in heaven, all authority on earth, in heaven and on earth is given to me. Is it not the same? He was given authority to reign. Now watch this. Watch this. Then Pharaoh took his signet ring off.

All right? Pharaoh did what? Took his signet ring off. I can't hear you. Are you sleeping? Pharaoh did what? Took his signet ring off. And put it on Joseph's hand. Promotion starts.

First thing he took is signet ring was the sign of rulership and authority. Those days, they used their signet ring to sign, to seal letters. It's a seal. The ring, he says, that's why when we marry, we exchange rings.

It's a seal. My seal, this is not mine, it's my wife's seal on my arm that I belong to her. My own is on her fingers and it's my seal.

[40:56] Those of you who take your own off, it's my seal on her fingers that she belongs to me. All right? So, most times, when men find a woman attractive, in responsible societies, the first thing they check out is her fingers.

Whether she belongs to. If they know she belongs to somebody, they just focus on other important things. If they realize she doesn't belong to anybody, they begin to be nice towards her. Hello, sister. Can we exchange that?

That's it. All right? So, in fact, where I grew up, it is quite repugnant or frowned upon to see a married woman or a married man not wearing a ring.

It's socially unacceptable because you are misleading others that you are available. Meanwhile, you are not available. You belong to somebody. And when you go to the wedding, remember, have you ever seen a bride?

This my ring is over. I'm in 14 years now. But it can come off. That tells you I don't put on weight. I'm not. I'm maybe. Yes. Now, have you ever seen that?

[42:04] What ring do you have to present to the woman or to yourself? They bring the ring. The man says, this is my ring. And then he puts it on his finger. Woman, you need to do your own.

I'm about to say something. Listen, if you didn't put the ring there, what gives you the right to take it off? Wow. You are disloyal.

Let, hey, take it off. Let him take it off because you gave him your finger and said, put it, it's a covenant. Put it there. Don't be angry and out of your anger, I'm tired.

I've taken it off. You didn't put it there, my girl, my man, my boy, you didn't put it there. I can tell you, your fingers are ready for something to be put there. You dare not take it off by yourself.

Your fingers are ready. Do you understand what I'm saying? Yes. Anyway, let me not get into marriage. So, the signet ring is a seal.

[43:05] When you see this, what does it mean? We are married. I think two weeks ago or three weeks ago, I saw one of the sisters, the whole team, she was wearing the ring, she was not in a relationship, I saw her wearing a ring here, but later on she had taken it off.

I noticed, you have to, if you have to, your eyes must be everywhere. What is this, what is this, so, last week I was talking to somebody, she was wearing the ring on her index finger on the right.

That doesn't matter. A lady. I saw the ring is nice, oh yeah, I like it, I bought it, and put it there. Thank God she didn't put it here. Because you tell people, stay away. I belong to somebody.

Why is it that you belong to somebody and you take your own off? You are 419. See, 419. Because, you are deceiving people.

In, in, is it, retail, it's called missealing. Yes, yes, yes, yes, yes, yes, Huh? That's the trading standards. Trading standards.

[44:11] We'll get hold of you. Alright, so, it's a sign of sin. Now, guess what? Joseph, when he was brought to Pharaoh, and Pharaoh was about to promote him, the first thing he did was give him a seal.

When we got born again, Bible says that he gave us the seal of the spirit. Ephesians chapter 1 verse 13. Sorry, verse 13, I'm sorry. And 4 verse 13.

Ephesians chapter 1 verse 13. Ephesians chapter 4 verse 13. He says, In him you also trusted after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, in whom also, having believed, you were what?

Sealed with what? The Holy Spirit of promise. So the Holy Spirit is the seal of God on your life that you belong to him permanently. Chapter 4 verse 30 says that, Do not grieve, and do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

So Joseph was given a signet ring which was a reflection of the fact that you are sealed. You have my endorsement. So his rulership had the endorsement of the highest power in the land.

[45:29] Your sonship has the endorsement of God by giving you the Holy Spirit. When Luke, I feel like I preach, I have a lot to share.

We are getting to something. Okay, all right. Luke chapter 15, verse 22. Luke 15, 22. Luke 15, 22. Luke 15, 22.

Is someone learning something at all? Luke 15, 22 says that, but the father said, this is a prodigal son. The father said to his servant, bring out the best robes and put it on him and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet.

When the prodigal son came back home, they gave him a robe and they put. All right, let's go to Genesis back. Genesis chapter 41, verse 42. Did we get to 42?

And Pharaoh took his signal ring off his hand and put it on Joseph's hand and he clothed him with garments of fine linen and put a gold of chain around his neck.

[46:27] Now, because of the time, I will comment on this. I'll comment on it tomorrow. I'll talk about the significance of the gap.

Remember, it's not garments. Garments. And then gold chain around his neck. You want gold chain? I'm going to show you how this looks like us tomorrow at the prayer meeting.

But today, I have to finish on the afternoon, because I've got just five minutes. It's the marriage thing that you guys made me talk about. All right. So, the next verse, verse 43.

And he had him ride in the second chariot which he had. And they cried out before him, bow the knee, so he set him over all the land.

They made him ride over chariots. Joseph, that's Jesus. He rode. And now, verse 43. Let me read it from my Bible, because I'm getting closer.

[47:31] I'm getting closer. Now we are on New Year's Eve. Verse 44. Pharaoh also said to Joseph, I am Pharaoh, and without your command, I am Pharaoh, and without your consent, no man may lift his hand or foot in the land of Egypt.

And Pharaoh called, let's all read that together. Let's go. And Pharaoh called Joseph to the king, and he gave him and the daughter of Potiphar, priest of Orn.

And Joseph went out over all the land. Pharaoh gave him the name in his ascension to the throne, Zaphonaph.

Zaphonaph. Pania. Zaphonaph Pania. What is the meaning of this, and what has it got to do with us? Zaphonaph Pania.

Three meanings. Three meanings. Number one. Now, in fact, in the Egyptian terms, some theologians believe that the actual meaning is different, but they actually believe that among the Egyptians, it means God speaks.

[48:54] And God, they, God is. God is, God is working. Joseph made them confess that God is working. But the actual meaning of Zaphonaph Pania, put you on the screen again.

Zaphonaph Pania means, number one, three meanings. Number one is the revealer of secrets. The revealer of secrets.

number two. Zaphonaph Pania means the savior of the world.

And number three, sustainer of life. who does this clearly depict? Now, that's why I took my time to talk to you about the tuples.

Types. The Greek word tuples. Types, figures, examples, samples. That there are so many samples in text that when you read the Bible and you don't see Christ inside, you have missed it.

[50:14] Zaphonaph Pania is not just a name for Joseph. It's an actual representation of Christ. Joseph was a strong depiction of Christ as the savior of the world.

As the revealer. In what way is Christ the revealer of secrets? Oh, come on. In Matthew chapter 13 from verse 1 to somewhere verse 40 and over or verse 50, I think so. He kept talking about parables.

He said, the kingdom of God is like this. The kingdom of God is like this. The kingdom of God. He was revealing and he told his disciples that the people who are not inside, these things are encoded, they don't know. But to you who are with me, let me show you the mysteries of the kingdom.

Jesus is the one who came to reveal the things of God to us. He's a revealer of secrets. There are secrets Jesus.

Thank you, Lord. I hear you. I hear you. I hear you. Listen. This is so strong. This is good. The secret of your destiny is in the church.

The Quran came to meet the Bible and the Bible is saying there's no other name. So if you come and introduce another name, you are a suspect. There's no other name under heaven given amongst men by which men must be saved.

When you've got Christ, you've got the best. I thought you'd be clapping for Jesus. He is the savior. Jesus is the savior. I mean, shout it, Jesus is my savior.

Shout it again, Jesus is my savior. Jesus is my savior. So, he's the revealer of secret, the savior of the world and unlike the last one, the sustainer of life.
