- Is it okay if we all read it from the screen? Let's go. Let's read it out. Let's go. Let's read it out loud again.
- How about time? Let's go. But he who looks... Some of you are not reading it. If you can see, please read. We want to read it loud, okay? Let's go.
- But he who looks into the perfect law of humility and is not forgetful hearer, but the law of the word, is one who lives in what he does.
- [1 : 16] You know what got my attention? From here. What word is that? Okay, read it. One more time.
- Louder, please. Can I hear the ladies' radio, please? Ladies, one more time. Gentlemen, let's go.
- Ladies are always better, you know. Ladies, let them see what I'm saying the truth. Ladies. This one will be blessed in what he does. All right, men, let them know that we are the men.
- Let's go. This one will be blessed in what he does. Which lady can get this one? Please. Shall we all read it aloud?
- This one will be blessed in what he does. Who wants to be this one? This one, there's no name there.
- [2 : 27] You can put your name there. You can put your name there. You know when you, let's say you are into sales, and you are selling, say you are selling this.
- You know the one who manufactured, they didn't know I would get this Bible. They didn't know I would get it. They didn't know. But they, someone like me, or someone like you, might buy it.
- But as for who gets it, whoever pays the price takes it. For sale. This one will be blessed. So to put yourself in the this one, you must look at the qualifications of a this one.
- Because this one is not a bit right. Everybody. No, no, no, no. Listen, life doesn't work for everybody. Wow. The whole, Jesus said something which was concerning.
- He said, the poor you always have with you. Always. Yeah. Wow. Jesus said it. Not me. Jesus. God said, the poor you always, so you can choose to be that kind of poor who always will be in town.
- [3 : 31] Yeah. Jesus said it. See? Wow. For you have the, he said, for you have the poor with you always. Me, you don't. But this is when the woman broke there.

And they said, why do you spend this money on Jesus? John chapter 12, verse 6, that's where Judas said, why do we spend all this money on him? We can't use it to feed the poor.

It's in John. It's in Matthew. It's in Luke. And it's in Mark. Okay. In Mark chapter 14. But they said, you can feed the poor.

What, verse 6, that's when Judas was saying it because he was a thief. When I saw, you've come to church, you are still fornicating. Hey! Oh!

Oh! Oh! Let the whole of last year, every month at least twice. Hey! Sometimes, four times.

[4 : 31] Hey! And sometimes, you yourself, you are wondering, where am I in church? Not that you don't want to be in church, but God should punish me. But God is not doing anything.

He is not doing anything to you. But God, don't you see I'm doing something wrong? But rather the pastor is saying that, I say God will bless you. Hey! God, why don't you?

There's a scripture in 2 Peter, which is, I think, chapter 3 or so. Chapter 2 or chapter 3, verse 9. It says that, God does not count slackness as some men do.

Yeah. Chapter 3, verse 9. The Lord is not slack. Do you know what it means to be slack? Relaxed and not serious about, is it like God is not serious about his promise?

No, no, no, no. The Lord is not slack concerning his promise. As some count slackness. Some people, you know. Okay, let's go to New Living Translation and the message and see how he puts it.

[5 : 37] The Lord isn't really being slow about this promise, as some people think. No. He is being patient for your sake. Why hasn't he acted?

He is being patient for your sake. Mm-hmm. He does not want anyone to be destroyed. He wants everyone to repent. That's why judgment hasn't, that's why the police hasn't caught you yet.

Right. That's why. Because they caught your friends. They lock them up. But you seem to be okay.

So, you keep doing. Because you think, oh God, God can't do anything. God can't do squat. He said, hey! God is not slack, as you are thinking.

Yeah. But he's just being patient. He doesn't want to pull the plug. Because he's trying to say, Judas, thief! Change! Thief!

[6 : 36] Change! Before you hang yourself, change! Change! Change! God is waiting. He has a long rope. Right. But one day, you run out of patience.

Yes! Yes! Unfortunately, there's no meter. There's no device to measure. You know, when you, when you, when you, your, the pressure, your boiler is over, you can tell from there.

Yes! So you can tell the pressure gauge. When you are, those of you who drive. When the fuel gauge is red. It tells you. But God's gauge for anger.

No one has it. No one has it. No one has it. No one has it. No one has it. You never know when God will say, enough! Yes! You made it to 2022.

You. So you think, oh God, he won't do anything. He won't do this guy. He won't do this guy. He said, God is not slack. As some men, because he's from his, as some count smugglers, but he's long, so you know what the meaning of long suffering?

[7 : 45] Suffering for a long time. Yeah. He's long suffering towards us. Yeah. He has a lot.

So people will be swearing, blasting God, and still he has long suffering. Wow. Wow. Insulting pastors and still have long suffering. Yeah.

It is a conundrum that Jesus had a thief as a bag keeper, money keeper. And he used to steal the money, like some of you used to do for your mother's bag.

Steal the money. Steal the money. You stole your mother's money, your brother's money, to go and blow it at the shard. Shard.

On Valentine's Day. You think I don't know. Especially those of you who have been gambling. Many gamblers are thieves.

[8 : 47] Because sometimes you need it because you just, you know the turnover will be big. So you pay back. It is a quick one. You said, turn around. It will be. He said, he was a thief.

And then Jesus said, listen, you guys are making monetary issues about somebody spending on me. He said, what the woman has done. Thank God he's a woman.

Women, when they want to worship, they can go far. Yeah. Yeah. Women are such a blessing. Yeah. God can use them so strongly. But the opposite is also true.

The devil can use them so badly. Yeah. Because women are powerful tools. Powerful tools.

Some of you who are quite intelligent. Satan can use you. If you don't allow God to use you. Yeah. Okay. Okay. So Jesus said, the poor you will always have with you.

[9 : 53] Now, I've gone so far. Let me come back to it. The poor you will always, you see. The poor you have with you always. That's the one I wanted. Not the Matthew one.

This one. He said, the poor you will always have with you. I want you to, okay. It's the Bible. So let's all read the first line. Let's read it out loud. For the poor you have with you always.

One more time. For the poor you have with you always. How many times will you have poor with you? Always. So, poor, is it the name of a car, a cat, or what? A type of person.

It's a type of person. So there are certain type of people that will always be there. Wow. Ah. So who are these people? Who are these people? And how do you make sure you are not part of them?

Amen. Yes. Because he said, you always have the poor. So what makes a person poor? And what constitutes the poor? He said, the poor.

[10 : 49] This is talking about money. He's not talking about poor spirits. Because their discussion was money. Judah said we should. And Judah said, you see, listen, let me advise you.

Let me. I think I should advise you. Please listen. You have to be careful who your allies are in church. This is very interesting. You have to be careful who your friends are in church.

Yeah. Because the kind of friends you make in church will determine the kind of things you will do. The quality of your service. How far the extent of your service.

And even the possibility of your sinning atmosphere. Because there are some friends. What you have, you can't live in sin. Yeah. You can't. Because they are always busy fasting and pursuing God.

When you are amongst them, you feel like you are the devil. And they won't say anything. But you know that they challenge you because you also love God. Yes. Because you love God. When you hang around with people who love God.

[11 : 49] It will enhance your love for God. It will make it easy for you to pursue. You can love God but still be behaving like a devil. Because your flesh never loves God. Everybody has the possibility to operate in your flesh or operate with your spirit.

Operating in the flesh is very natural and very normal. Operating in the spirit is like swimming upstream. So then you have to intentionally select some allies who are also pursuing God.

So you can pursue God with them. And it makes it easier. The Bible says in 2 Timothy chapter 2 verse 22. Flee youthful lust.

Flee youthful lust. So when you are young, you are likely to be very lustful. Lust. What is lust?

Desires. That seem to have so strong in you. But it's not pleasing to God. Lust. And when you are young, your energies are strong.

[12 : 52] Yeah. So when you have feelings for some things, it's also strong feelings. It's strong. It's true. I don't know if you know what I'm talking about. Sometimes you just want peace in serving God.

You want to do what is right. You just want to pursue. But there is this side of you that is always... Ah! Ah! Why? Oh, wretched man that I am.

Who can deliver me from this body of death? Ah! Oh, wretched man. Oh, wretched man that I am. Oh, God. Who will deliver me from this body of death?

But I thank God for the next verse. Ah! I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. Ah! Someone say, thanks be to God.

Thanks be to God. Say, thanks be to God. Thanks be to God. That means there's a way out. Amen. Sit down. Flee youthful lust.

[13 : 52] Kadabahayana. Yes! He said, flee youthful lust. Yes. But pursue, pursue righteousness. What should you pursue? No weed. No weed. Yeah. Yeah. Mm-hmm. Pursue it.

Most people are waiting for God to do it for them. No! You will put yourself in the category of the poor if you don't do something. How can you pass exam by wishing?

You have a dream. Have a dream. Martin Luther King. Have a dream. Now one day I'll pass an exam. One day I'll pass an exam. One day I'll pass an exam.

One day I'll pass an exam. You are not steady, no. You are living in a fool's paradise. Nothing happens, nothing of value happens without an effort.

[14 : 57] It is what it is. You just have to take responsibility and do something. Yeah. Do something. So, everything you want in life, you must know it has a price tag.

That's what I'm trying to say. Yeah. It has a price tag. He said you always have the poor. So, who are those who will not be part of the poor? There are things to do to advantage your future.

Yes. Yes. I'm talking about the advantage of service. What? Wow. Wow. Wow. Wow. Wow. Wow. Wow. He said, see it. This man will be blessed.

Ah. So, there are some people who have on their lives a tag of will be blessed. You put them in the desert.

What happens? They will be blessed. You put them in the North Pole. On the North Pole. What will happen? They will be blessed. You put them near Bermuda Triangle.

[16 : 02] Yes. Yes. Yes. Yes. Yes. What do you mean by they will be blessed? Listen. God's word works everywhere. Oh. Oh. Wow. It works everywhere. There is no place on this earth where human beings have it and there's no toilet there.

Mm-hmm. Wow. Where there are human beings, there will be food and there will be toilets. Mm-hmm. There might not be a built-up toilet, but there's a place.

Not in the bedroom. There's a place. Yeah. Yeah. There's no place where human beings are where there will not be sickness. So, don't mind people who talk like that.

He said, number one, you have to see it. He who looks into the perfect law of liberty, this talking about the word of God, and continue. That's the second one.

There are some of us, you will look into it, we are reading, but after the church, you've forgotten everything. Amen. You don't continue in it. Wow. You don't continue in it. He says that, see it a man, and look, this is, whoever looks into the perfect law of liberty, and continues, and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of what?

[17 : 26] Of what? Of what? That means when you look into it, you will see work. Yeah. It's not feelings. It's not, oh, oh, oh, oh. When do people say, oh, how do I feel about God?

How do I feel about God? How do I feel about God? Let them settle down. Good. It's good to feel that way. But validate the feeling with the work. Yeah. Okay. Validate your feelings with the work. You are still bitter against your mother, your sister, your ex, and you say, the way I feel about God.

I love you, God. I love you, God. When you go, you still are bitter against this. I will never forgive you. That crying, that feeling is fake. It's not genuine towards God.

It's just you. It's just about you. Because if it's about God, it excuses you out. It takes you. Get out of the way and let God have his way. Jesus, in the garden of Gethsemane, he was praying, he said, I wish this cup comes to pass.

Matthew chapter 26, verse 39. I wish this doesn't come to pass. But he said, not as I will, but let your will be done. Until you say, let your will be done, you are not actually on the road of really obeying God.

[18 : 34] If you want to obey God, you are willing to say, how many of you know sometimes you just are not ready for that? Sometimes you are not ready for that. No. Especially when you really have to hit somebody back.

Or there is something you really want to do. You are. He who looks into this perfect law of liberty. And continues therein. But it's not a forgetful, but doer of the work.

He said, now you can talk about this man. Your blessing is not based on who is praying for you. Please. Please. Okay. Please. If blessing has to just happen because somebody prays for you, it will be very easy.

Because everybody here will be having A stars in your school. Yeah. Because the kind of prayers have prayed for you. Some of you have prayed for you, but you failed. You failed.

When you were referred in that, they didn't, they didn't, weren't you in church before you were referred? Yeah. But you didn't study. There's work that goes with everything.

[19 : 37] There are people who, bishops have blessed, sit down please. Bishops have blessed their marriage. Ended up their marriage, they ended up in divorce. The fact that big men of God come into your wedding.

Hey, you have a brother, we bless you. Please. When you get them, go and do the work. Do the work. Do the work. Blessings follow work.

Okay. That Christianity that does not saddle you with work is not helping you. It's religion. It will kill you alive. You are being roasted alive and you don't see why.

Where is God? Where is God? You are still roasting. Where is God? Where is God? He's been in the same place when Jesus was dying. He's still the same place. Seeth a man, he who looks into the, this is a perfect law of liberty.

He says, no law of bondage. He said, law of liberty. You want to be free? You want to be free? It's the law of liberty. I am telling you, if you spend your time for God, God will take care of you.

[20 : 42] God will take care of you. The point I'm making is that this man shall be blessed. This man. There is, there are people who are, who fall into the category of this one.

And that day I tasted this one. I tasted this one. I tasted this one. Because I wanted to do God's work at any cost. Sickness said, no I can't stay with you. I have to leave.

I have, I don't know who I'm preaching to. I have to leave. Sickness cannot take over your life. Shout hallelujah. Hallelujah.

Everybody has got an account. As soon as you become a Christian, as soon as, when I say a Christian, I don't mean your mother, you can't be born as a Christian, okay? Nobody gets born as a Christian.

Let's, let's settle that. You can never be born as a Christian. You can't. It's not possible. You can be born as a child of God. You can be born into the Christian religion.

[21 : 41] But that doesn't make you a member of the church of God. No, the church of God, you must come under the blood. By willingly asking Jesus to take over the reins of your life.

They are two different things. Or you cannot be saved through somebody. You have to meet Jesus yourself. It's a very personal one on one.

But this scripture we read, there are things to do to guarantee blessings. This year you must encounter such blessings. Yeah!

And so there are quickly, there are things, there are things that when you do, it gives you an advantage over a lot of people. Paul, in first Timothy chapter, 1 verse 13.

He said, although I was formerly a blasphemer, I persecuted the church and I was a little man, but I obtained mercy. Why? Why?

[22 : 44] Now I've told you, so you can't say you're ignorant. But number 2, which is the key one, is the scripture I showed you. The man who looks into the law of liberty.

I've spent all my life really being a Christian, not just a pastor. That's right. That's right. That's right. That's the difference. Genuine. Genuine Christian, not a pastor, not looking for francis, not looking for money.

I genuinely serve God with the entirety of my life. And when you go into ministry for source of earning, you'll be stranded on the way. But if you do it because you don't care what happens, if you don't get, you just, you are, you are, you are dedicated and you are dying for the work of God.

God will bless you in a way. And then you don't focus on blessing. Because if the blessing doesn't, if you are doing it for the blessing, then that means that you have an ulterior motive. Yeah.

A secret agenda. But if you are just doing it because you just are sold out to God, that's a different story. Yeah. That's a different, and that's my story. That's why I can be standing here speaking with passion. Sandiapur.

[23 : 54] Listen, I don't need to be paid to do what I'm doing. I don't care. I don't care. Payments. There are many places I've preached and they are confused because when you go and preach, you travel and come, they will honor you.

Please, this is a little bit, it's not payment, it's called honorarium. Just to honor you for coming. And I've rejected it. I've rejected separate. In fact, the first time I was invited to preach in Bishop Darke's church in London, when I went, later I heard him talking about it.

When I went, I went with my thousands of offering to go and honor him, he wasn't there. That this man has built such a great church and I have the privilege to come and preach here and I want you to take money for preaching.

That's why I don't understand when people play music in their church and they want to be paid. It's madness, Paris Salah. Because I lived a life.

For many years, the beginning of Carys, many years, I never knew what paycheck is. Never once. Because I thought that we were just serving God. I thought that we were just serving God.

[25 : 00] Thank God I didn't have children. Yeah. Many years! I lived my life. Leave me at the altar with my heart. I gave my life as a genuine living sacrifice.

Never messed up. I wouldn't lie. I don't lie. I never watched Pono. Pono, sorry. Is it the same? I'm genuine about this thing.

Genuine! I'm telling you! Genuine about it! Genuine about it! Little did I know that when you get born again, God opens an account for you.

And then whatever you are doing, the deposit is being made into your account towards the future. The deposit. Pastor, where is it in the Bible that talks about people who have accounts? Well, that's, I'll show you.

It's because you've not been reading your Bible, that's why you're asking me this question. But no problem, I'm happy you asked. Because some of you, you don't have, your account is zero! Yeah! Yeah!

[26 : 11] That's why you are still believing God for marriage. You are believing God for breakthrough. You are believing God for freedom. Because there's nothing in your account! You are born again! And two years you've been born again!

What do you have in your account? What can you show for in your account? So, Pastor, how do I load my account? That's why this... That's what has helped me! If I had not loaded up my account...

My darling, what's your name? Katrina. Katrina. Katrina, if I had not loaded my account, look, without the equity I had, academic equity, I would have been stranded in life. I would have been stranded.

But, why am I saying that? I know other friends. Some even went to uni. But they are still, they left everything and did ministry. But because they didn't, they did it differently, many of them are stranded. Many of them are stranded.

Many of them are stranded. Life is hard! Yeah! Even when you finish uni, life can be hard! University doesn't guarantee you, you excel in life.

[27 : 14] But please, use that route at least. It can give you a certain decent... I mean, considerable earning. When you see someone who is working, working, working, working, and earning little, little, little, it's because it's a lack of education.

It's true now. You go and ask your family members. They'll tell you. When you are highly educated, you don't work too long.

Yes. Consultants, they work two days, three days. And they earn what a doctor, more than a doctor can earn in a month. They earn two days. Yeah.

And they work from home as well. Consultants, work from home. Yeah. The doctor will work seven days. Seven days. Working is good, especially when you are young. Some of you, the way you don't like work, it shows in your academic exercise.

You don't like work. You like wearing trainers. This man, this one will be blessed. This one, listen. I have a guaranteed blessing in towards my future. My future will not be miserable.

[28 : 19] It can be. And it is going to enter the future of my children. And people who are connected to me. Like you. Like you. Like you. Like you. Like you. Like you. Like you. Like you.

Like you. Like you. Like you. Like you. Like you. Shut him in! Shut him in! There are things when you do in God, don't do it once and for all.

You used to be in the choir. There are some of you men. Men! Men! Men! Because of rehearsal. Laziness towards rehearsal. You don't want to join the choir. Wow. Meanwhile, you are trying to get a camera with an album.

You are joking. Not on God's blessings. Yeah. By the end of this month, there are some guys here. You must join the ashes. You must join the choir.

You must join. You claim you are strong. Use it for God. Use it for God because, listen, there are things in your past that are meant to hurt you.

[29 : 20] Like, when I abandoned education, that could have hurt me wrongly. Because it was a bad move. It was a bad move, but I was ignorant.

Yeah. That's why I will not allow you to do that. But how did I escape? Because of my equity in God. I put in so much.

The dividends over way. What is in my past could hurt my future. Now, my mother-in-law. When she sees me, she's too happy. When she says, here's my goal.

She loves me so much. Yeah. The person who said no. And rightfully so. Today, because of the account I have in heaven, she has been proved wrong.

Not that she was actually wrong. She was not wrong. But the account overshadowed the weakness. Yeah. Some of you, your background is not favorable.

[30 : 23] That bad things your father has done. Your father has done. And you yourself, you are here. Come on. You have made your mother cry. You've made your father cry. You have had, you've insulted and abused your father before.

No. It's a curse. And he's, maybe he's dead now. I feel sorry for you. I feel sorry for you. This is the time to start getting busy investing into your future.

Yes. Find ways and load up your account. Yes. Such a way that by the time you get to your, you are getting into a days of greatness, days of marriage, days of favor, before what could hurt you kicks in, you are overshadowed by this abundance you have stored up.

Let's finish the text. He said, you sent once again. You sent aid. Say aid. Aid. Once and again for who? My necessity.

They saw Paul is doing the work of God. He will need this. Let's give it to him. Let's do it. They were sending to him. To Paul, not to the church. Said to my, it's not to the churches, said to my necessities.

[31 : 34] Those people who think that blessing a pastor is a problem. They have missed God. Amen. You sent aid. Once and again to my necessity.

Look at the next verse. That's where I'm going. Not that I seek the gift, but I seek what? Through the Lord. I have an account.

I have an account. He said, so how do I load it up? You keep sending once and again. Sending once and again. And I'm encouraging you. Not because I'm in need.

I have need, but I can't do without it. Because when you look at the text. When you look at the text in the verse 14. In fact, actually, verse 12. Verse 12. From the verse 12. He said, I know how to abase.

To be abased. And I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things, I have learned both to be full and to be hungry. Both to abound and to suffer need. So me, I'm fine.

[32 : 31] Whether I have or I don't have. I've learned it. He said, I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. This is there. I can do it. So he's talking about, it's not my need. But I have the need.

But what number, if you're a pure man of God. You're a genuine man of God. You don't do your man of Godship based on your needs. You do it based on his needs. So I don't care. He said, so why are you telling us that the things we are sending to you to help you is good?

He said, because I know you haven't realized that you have an account. And I'm speaking by virtue of your account. Look at the verse 18 again. He says that, verse 17, I'm sorry.

He said, not that I seek a gift, but I seek fruits that will abound. That abound to your account. Wow. Say my account.

My account. So you must learn how to keep letting things abound to your account. And then look at the next verse. Indeed, I have all and abound.

[33 : 31] I am full. Have you received from Epaphroditus the things sent from you? So when I was in Thessalonica, you kept sending, tell the Philippian church, you kept sending things for my needs.

He said, I've received and I've had so much. I'm full. No, he's talking about him. Then look at that. Look at this. People don't see. Brothers and sisters. He said, oh, sorry. I'm too much on fire.

I have to finish. I've taken too much of your time. Watch this. Watch this. Watch this. He says that you sent through, this is not Epaphroditus. Okay. This is Epaphroditus.

Epaphroditus. The things sent from you. Watch this. A sweet smelling aroma. Huh? Watch this. An acceptable what?

Sacrifice. Well pleasing to who? God. Ah, excuse me. But we sent it to you. Holy. You are saying that God is pleased with it? How do you know?

[34 : 32] Because I liked it. Because it made a difference for me. It touched my heart. I know it was. You touched my heart in this way. You have touched the heart of God. When you are asked to serve in church, don't think you are doing it for your leader.

You are, as you are doing, when the leader feels like, ha, this guy, every time I ask you to do something, you do it so well. You make it so light for me. Once the leader said, ha, God bless.

God has also said, ha. And guess what? That ha, ha, loads up your account. That is why it's dangerous to keep listening to negative stories about men of God, God is sent you to serve.

Because you will downgrade your service and then guess what? You downgrade your account. Yeah. Hungry. Hungry. An empty account. How do you load your account?

Your service. Your honor. Your service to God, to God's people. Your honor to God's servants. These are ways. Come on.

[35 : 43] Come on. Hey. It's just a man. It wasn't a man talking. Yes. And a man was saying that, I receive it and I'm happy. Yes. And it's a sweet smelling aroma to God.

It has to hear the nose of God. How does he know? It's an acceptable sacrifice. Who accepted it? Are you the one to accept it on behalf of God? Yeah, they brought it to me. But I'm telling you, it's an acceptable sacrifice to God.

And he said, I'm saying this. Then, guess what he did? He said, therefore my God. Look at your Bible.

And my God. Didn't say our God. My God shall supply all your needs. Watch. Watch this. Whose needs?

Whose needs is God going to supply? If your God can supply needs. Why didn't he supply your own pastor? Okay. I supply your needs. Now you're telling me your God will supply my needs.

[36 : 43] He said, yes, that's how it works. Let me explain it. Because your account must be loaded. And God supplies based on your account. How do you load your account?

Service in God. Most of you, you don't do anything in church. You don't do anything. You only look important. You only look powerful.

What kind of worship is this? Where is your service? Where is your service? Where is your service? Where is your service? You are rather a commentator.

Commenting on how this one has done it right. How this one has done it well. How this one has done it this. You are busy commenting. But you don't have a service. How can you be in church without and out of service?

How can you do that? How? And even if you want to be in service, the pastor must see the way you are serving. Yeah, you hear? Listen, you are not getting anything in your account.

[37 : 46] If you do it for men to see it, he said, your heavenly father will not reward you. But I said, if you do it before God and just between you and God, God will reward you.
