You'll bring it. But there was a man, he came. He came with his offering. He said, I'm going. But when he got to the offering, the altar, he put the offering down.

He went back. But he felt, no, this is not enough for God. Then he looked for something else. He took it. He left it at the altar.

Leave me at the altar. Leave my father. His girlfriend said, his girlfriend called. He said, let's go. He said, no.

[3 : 00] Shout hallelujah. I am a worship. So. When you go to work on Monday. Or you go to uni. Or you go back to school.

Or you go wherever. And your friends realize that your attitude has changed. You are not even doing things like they used to do. You tell them. They say let's go. But I said no.

I can't go. So what's wrong with you? Leave me. Leave me now. I'm already a sacrifice. Leave me at the altar. With my father. Leave me at the altar.

From verse 1. It talks about the sacrifices they did. All the things they did in the Old Testament. For the Lord. Having a shadow of the good things to come. And not the very image of the things.

Can never with these sacrifices. Same sacrifices. Which are all free. Can never with these same sacrifices. Which they offer continually. Year by year. Make those who approach perfect.

[4 : 53] He began to talk about everything happening in the Old Testament. He said. It was good. God instituted it. But it couldn't do the job. It was just a shadow of the original.

So you see. We can. I'll mention. I'll mention. The dancing of David. The dancing of David is nonsense. In the absence of our dancing. Because Hebrews says that.

Hebrews. Hebrews again. He says that. All these guys were not made perfect without us. So when you read Hebrews chapter 11. The last verse. Verse 40. He said these guys. The great guys of faith.

He said that. God having a better promise. That they should not be made perfect apart from us. In other words. What they have done. Is good. But. It is not complete without us. So my worship. Validates what David was doing in the Old Testament. My singing. My preaching. Everything we are doing. Me being a sacrifice. On the altar. Begins to give meaning to the sacrifices.

[5 : 52] They used to do in the Old Testament. But since when did that change? It changed because when you read down. What Hebrews chapter 10. You go down. What verse 8. 9 there. It talks about Jesus. Jesus Christ.

He is also a high priest. But those days. The high priest go to the. The altar. With the sacrifice. They go with the sacrifice. So. Let's say.

I am a high priest. Minister. Can I use you please? So. This is my sacrifice. Like Abraham. And Isaac. See. So. Abraham said. Isaac. Let's go. God said.

I need a sacrifice. That's the difference between giving an offering. And giving yourself. Abraham. Let's go. Isaac said. Abraham said. Let's go. They go to the.

Altar. To lie down. He was the sacrifice. On the altar. Okay. That's what they used to do. And so. The high priests. Also came. Every high priest.

[6 : 45] Always had something to offer. According to Hebrews chapter 8. Verse 1. 2. 3. And Hebrews chapter 5. Said. Every high priest. You must have something to offer. That's what makes you a high priest.

If you can. How can you be an MP. Without representing anybody. Wow. Who are you. Who are you. Where's your constituency. Where. Where. Where. You can't be an MP.

Without representing anybody. You can't say I represent myself. You are not an MP. You are an advocate. You are a. What. What do you call it. You are trying to stand for something.

You know. You are an advocate. Or. Active. Activist. That's the word I'm trying. Activist. But you are not an MP. The MP doesn't speak for himself.

He speaks for the others. So high priest. According to Hebrews chapter 8. Every high priest. Is supposed to have. Something. For every high priest. Is appointed to offer. Both gifts.

[7 : 41] And sacrifices. So if you are a high priest. You must have something too. For. Therefore. It is necessary that. This one. Jesus also. Being a high priest. He must also have a sacrifice. Because.

A high priest. Without a sacrifice. Is not a high priest. Is not a high priest. High priest.

Without a love. You are not a high priest. So. Isaac. Abraham brought Isaac. Now the priest. Will also bring. So I'm a high priest.

I'm going. In fact. The high priest. Is like. An MP. Sort of. He. He. Sends. He sacrifices. On the behalf of the people. Okay.

That's the difference. Between those type of high priest. They have to sacrifice. Bring a sacrifice. For. First of all. According to Hebrews chapter 5. For their sins. And then.

[8 : 36] The sins of the people. Yeah. Verse 1. For every high priest. Taken from among men. Is appointed. For men. In things pertaining to God. That they may offer. Both gifts and sacrifice.

Is not the same thing. Chapter 8. Verse 1. Said. Now look at the verse 2. Look at the verse 2. Hebrews chapter 5. Verse 2. He can have compassion. On those who are ignorant. And going

astray. Since he himself.

Is also subject to weakness. Verse 3. Because of this. He is required. As for the people. So also. For himself. To offer. Sacrifices.

For what? Sins. So when the high priest. Comes to the altar. He is bringing a sacrifice. For two groups of people. Number one. Is himself. Number two.

Is the rest of the people. So. They must always have a sacrifice. And God. Clearly stipulated. What sort of sacrifice it is. But our Jesus. He is also a high priest.

[9 : 31] When he came. I need another high priest. Yeah. You look like one. Please come. So. You are. The old testament high priest.

Take your. Sacrifice. To the altar. You take the sacrifice. And then. Leave the sacrifice. At the altar. And then he will leave. His sacrifice. And go. And then go.

Then the next year. He comes again. And then leave the sacrifice. And go. Okay. So now. This. Sacrifice. Two high priests. One type is old testament. That's why it's wearing yellow.

And I'm also another type of high priest. You know. Isaac asked his father. Where is the. Lamb. Father. The knife. Genesis chapter 22. Father. The knife.

Father. The firewood. But where is the. Sacrifice. Abraham said. God will show. It's the same thing that happened to Jesus. Two people. Jesus is a type of high priest. And old testament type of high priest.

[10 : 28] They were all going to the altar. One had sacrifice. But he says he didn't have sacrifice. But a high priest is supposed to offer. Gifts and sacrifice. So what is he going. No. He said. Leave me at the altar. Me myself. I'm the sacrifice.

So Jesus Christ. Became the first. Sacrificer. Without a sacrifice. By himself. So Jesus came to offer himself.

As a sacrifice. And now from that time. Became a model for you. And I. Who claim to be born again. To be the actual sacrifice. On the altar. So what we say.
