[13:00] Hallelujah! Hallelujah! Hallelujah! God said Ephesians chapter 1. This is how the text is structured.

In Ephesians chapter 1, he opens the text with blessed be God.

So he opens the text from verse 3 with how God be blessed. Then he went and said, who has blessed with all spiritual blessings in heaven? Then from verse 4, he begins to talk a bit more about the things God has done.

Alright? So blessed be God who has blessed with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places. And then verse 4 says, according to us, he has chosen us in him before the foundation. God has done a lot for us.

Go to verse 5. Let me show you something. Having predestinated us unto adoption as sons. God has chosen us to be a son of God. So before you even stop sinning, your destination was to be a son of God.

[14:01] Hallelujah! Wait, wait, wait. That's all. So, it's called predestination. Your destination was set before you started the journey. Predestined. So, some of us, when we were even quaffing and messing up, sleeping around, fooling around, insulting church, doing all that, when you knew you were a sinner.

He decides to advise himself, you know, I want to help you. He has planned. See, what God does for you is not by accident. It's my program.

Yeah. And he does that. So he said, according to the pleasure of Luke 6, to the praise of his glory, to the praise of the glory of his grace, so that someone can just give him the, all he's doing is, he's done all this.

To the praise of the glory. Shout hallelujah. You deserve it. You deserve it.

You deserve it. Remember your family. You deserve it. You deserve it.

[21:05] My hallelujah. My hallelujah belongs to you. I know why. I know why. I know why.

You should tell the devil, I will not feel so push. I can't say hallelujah. No way. Hallelujah. Hallelujah. Hallelujah. I may look like I'm crazy. It doesn't matter. Shout hallelujah.

In the book of Ephesians, Ephesians opens with, blessed be God. And then after talking about God, God was the subject.

[23:47] From verse 3, it said, blessed be the God and the Father. Ephesians chapter, verse 3. Blessed be the God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us.

So, he said, and he has predestined us unto adoption. He has predestined us unto adoption according to the good of, why? To the praise of his, the glory of his grace.

So, that's about God. I thought that was in the end. And the next verse said, the next verse. Sorry, let's go to the previous verse, I'll show you something. The next verse, talking about, to the praise of his glory, he has made us accepted, wherein he has made us accepted in the beloved.

[24:57] You can remain a living atheist, but you can't die as one. On your deathbed, you realize that death is not the end.

But unfortunately, they don't get the chance to say it. It's important. You can't come back to say, oh, please, I made a mistake. Forgiveness of sins.

Tell someone, we are the forgiving people. We are the forgiving people. Go to the next verse. Let me show you something. So, who is he talking about now? Jesus Christ. Listen to this.

Go to the next verse. Look at verse 12.

That we should be to the praise of his glory. Who first trusted Jesus Christ. So, after addressing God, he said, to the praise of his glory.

[26:25] Then he brought Jesus Christ, who's glad-washed us, to the praise of his glory. I thought that would be the end. Then he goes on again, the verse 13. In whom he also trusted, after you were, if you have heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation.

In whom, also after that you believed, he were sealed. Then he brings the Holy Spirit in. Have you seen that? The Trinity is appearing. This is called the Trinitarian formula. Right in the beginning of Ephesians.

He didn't talk about anything, but started talking about God the Father, what he has done. And how Jesus Christ has executed what God has done. So, God planned it to the praise of his glory. Jesus executed it to the praise of his glory.

And the Holy Spirit applied it. So, the Holy Spirit, go to the next verse. Verse 14. Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchase.

He says, All to the praise of his glory. Haven't you noticed that everything God is doing, he's executing, he's applying, is just to the praise of his glory.

[27:30] How come you come to church and your hallelujah is missing? Hallelujah! Give it to him, shout hallelujah! Hallelujah! Hallelujah!

You deserve the glory. And it talks about how that unto him who is able to do exceedingly, abundantly, above all that we can. Ephesians chapter 3 verse 20.

Above all that we can. Is someone getting something? Yes! Unto him who is able to do exceedingly, abundantly, above all you can think or ask of. According to the power that works in us. You know, a few weeks ago, I spoke about this text heavily.

And this is where I dwelt. That what you hear, what you think, determine what you get. Okay, so, we modern day church, we focus a lot on this, which is not bad. But if you only focus on this, you are misplaced.

Because that's now, he said, now unto him, you can chop this out. That is able.

[28:41] So, pastor, can you, can you please come? So, now unto him. Who is wearing this nice tie and this vest or three-piece suit?

Is that it? So, why then are you making, oh, nice tie, three-piece suit? No, I will say something. Hmm. Hmm. So, that is able to do exceedingly. I'm just, it's, it's an adverb.

No, adjective, sorry. An adjective. It's a, an ad, qualifying, an adjetival statement. Hey! So, so, this, this, to be honest, from here unto him, give me new, new KJ so we can get the hymn to the capital.

Now, to him, parenthetical statement. You can put this in brackets. Okay. Which is able, it's just describing God. So, you can take this out of the text and it actually doesn't change what he's actually saying.

Yeah. So, which is able to do exceedingly, that's telling about God. Who, what, so, but, so, but he said unto him. Okay. So, now what are you going to say?

[29:56] Is, you got distracted to talk about what God is able to do. You tried. So, that is a statement that can be taken out, cut out. Brackets.

You can put them in brackets. It doesn't spoil the, the, the integrity of the text. It doesn't affect it. Because it's parenthetical. Now, so he said, unto him who is able to do exceedingly, pastor, thank you very much.

Who is able to do exceedingly above all that we can ask or think of. Okay. Sorry. According to the power that works in us. Yeah. Tell us what he said. Then, so we always stop at verse 20.

To him. To him. Listen.

So, this is what he's trying to say. Unto God. What about God? You see, all the testimonies, who is able to do. He has seen about anything that has happened.

[30:58] All the things. Okay. So, unto God. But what he's trying to say? Unto God. Be the glory in the church by Jesus Christ throughout all generations.

Teach your children to say hallelujah. Hallelujah. Because it's generational. Throughout all generations.

Forever. Ever. Don't underestimate the value of your hallelujah to God. So in conclusion Your hallelujah Should be an attachment To your breath As long as you can breathe There is still hallelujah Hallelujah So one day David in the book of Psalms He said God That I might praise you Whilst I'm alive Because if I go to the grave The grave cannot praise you Life is for praising Not complaining Your praising

Watch this I'm about to say something very strong Your praising moves heaven Quicker than your praying Hallelujah You didn't get it You're praising God Moves heaven Quicker than your praying Oh Lord I'm dying Why?

Amen For those of you who may not know Life is not a right Amen Amen Amen Amen You have a right to so many things in life But life is not a right Amen Amen Amen Amen Amen Amen Those who died 9-11.

You should be able to scream anyhow in Hallelujah without fear It doesn't matter what comes your way God always deserves It's okay to lose your composure It's okay to lose your cool It's okay to act crazy Let them think you are crazy And give him the praise Give him the glory Give him the honor Give him the praise
