So then you have to believe God for grace to continue in things that you need to continue in. Now when it came to the apostles, they said, we will give ourselves continually to the ministry of the word, to prayer, and the ministry of the word.

Verse 4, Acts 6. That's what will make their ministry or their assignment in life get fulfilled. If you are a student, you have to continue in studying.

Do you understand what I'm saying? You have to continue in studying. To be a good husband, you have to continue in ignoring a lot of things that are worth ignoring.

It's not everything you complain about. So you've done well so far. Continue. If you are going to be a good wife, there are things you have to continue in not talking about.

He went to, and as long as his hair was there, he was fine. As long as his hair. See, so what was keeping him for his destiny, if you go and copy him and think he's got away with this so you also get away, the destinies are different.
