[1:05] What's pillar number one? Huh? I can't hear you. Pillar number two. Pillar number three.

Pillar number four. Pillar number five. You don't know? All right. Do you want me to just go ahead or I should do a recap? All right.

So, pillar number one is what? Love God. What is this? What pillar is this supposed to be for? What are these pillars? Destinies. Pillars of destiny.

It's if you don't love God. There's no guarantee for your destiny. Oh, come on. When you do God, it does your destiny. Do God and save your future.

Why? Because you are a God lover. So you want your destiny to be secured. Love God. Number two, have faith in God. What does it mean to have faith in God?

You believe that what God said he will do, he will do it. Ah. So if God said, I'll bless you, means I'll bless you. So if God says, I'll break up with that boy and I'll bless you, why don't you have faith in God and do it?

Go ahead and do that. Obey God. Obedience to God. There's nothing that reflects faith in God like obedience to God. How can you obey God, the God you don't believe in?

So when you obey God, it's a reflection of the faith you have in God. What's the point in coming to church without obeying God? Think about it.

If you want to know how to do something well. Go to those who have done it well. And learn from those who have done it well. You know Jesus told the parable of ten virgins.

[14:49] Five wise virgins. And five foolish ones. Matthew chapter 25. He said they were all waiting for their groom to come. And they waited and waited.

But it was delaying. So the five wise virgins went. And bought extra oil. For their lamb. Those days. It's like charging your battery. You know when you are traveling.

You are going somewhere. You make sure your battery is on full charge. And then if it's going to be a long journey. But you'll be listening to a lot of music. Or using your phone online. And locked.

Then you need battery pack. Right? Is it called battery pack? Power bank. Power bank. Yeah. Power bank. Now there are different types of power banks. Some you can stick behind your phone.

Be careful what you are doing. Be careful the places you go. Be careful what you keep listening to. Be careful what you keep watching. And be careful who you keep hanging out with. These are the ways to prepare for your future.

Who you hang out with. What you keep listening to. What you keep watching. And where you keep going. Will determine the outcome of your life. Whether you are a good person or you are a bad person.

[16:46] If you are a bad person. And you work with good people. With time. You begin to have good mannerisms. If you are a good person. And you work with bad people.

With time. The Bible says that evil association or communication corrupts good manners. I think 1 Corinthians chapter 15. I believe it is 33.

Yeah. Do not be deceived. Evil company. Did you see that? Evil company will corrupt good habits. You have a good habit.

But your friends. The people you are working with. The people you hang around with. Will invariably pollute your good habits. Bad company. Evil company corrupts good habits.

Let's look at how the New Living Translation puts it. Wow. Don't be fooled by those who say something. They say certain things that he was talking about earlier.

[17:42] Bad company corrupts good habits. Message. Some of you asked that earlier. It's so lovely. The same thing. I see where the people.

You see. The King James put it. And New King James put it so clear. All the simplified ones couldn't put it any simplified. Any much simplified. Yeah.

Don't be deceived. Evil communication. So New King James. Evil company. Corrupts good manners. So who you keep company with.

What affects you. So mentorship is such an important aspect of destiny. Do you know Paul. When he met Jesus. He said what do you want me to do.

Jesus said go to Damascus. And this is very interesting. He said go. The Lord said to the. Arise go to the city. And you will be what. Told. Those who say to me.

[18:35] I don't want anyone to tell. No one can tell me what to do. You have a failure. In. In the making. Oh you definitely. You are on the root for. You can't. You can't. You can't buy a mobile phone.

And say no one can teach me. No one can tell me what to do. But the one who made it. Must tell you what this phone can do. Who made the phone. Sorry. So.

He said go. Jesus said. Me I can't tell you. There are human beings on earth. On ground. Who have what it takes to tell you. What you must do. And how you get to where you are going. So when you get born again.

The first thing you do. Is to make sure. That you are committed. Or you are. Accountable. To somebody in church. That's how you can live.

A successful Christian life. But this. Lone Ranger. Insulated. Isolated. Segregated. Kind of Christian life. You are just by yourself. It's you and you alone.

You are not accountable. It's between you and God. Excuse me. Give me a break. That's one of the things. I just can't. No rational. Some person should say that. It's between you and God. It's between you and God come to preach to you?

Did God give you the Bible? Where do you get a Bible from? Didn't you buy it from someone? Someone gave it to you? Did he throw it from heaven to you? Wow.

How can you be so childish. And pediatric. And say that it's between. It's just between me and God. You don't need anybody. Excuse me. You always need people.

You always need people. And sometimes you need even family members who are not born again. You still need them. You need them.

You are born again. But you don't like this. You're family. But you still need them. They are your family. You always need people. You will always. It said Luke chapter 6 verse 36 or 38.

Yeah 38. Give and it shall be given unto you. Verse 38. Give and it shall be given unto you. Good measure. Press down. Shaking together. Running over. We'll be put into.

King James. Give me King James. I prefer the King James. King James uses a word deader. Give and it shall be given unto you. Good measure. Press down. Shaking together. Running over. Shall. God. No God.

He said. I am indeed a Jew. Born in thousands of. He can trace his origin. So I'm a very powerful man. Where are you coming from? You are Elijah the Tishbite.

Where are you coming from? Who raised you? Who taught you that Christian things? Who prayed for you? Who laid hands on you? Where are you coming from?

Now. Where can. Where can. Where can. Where can. Where can be this too? Where can. Where can. Where. Where. Where can be this? This kind of. Anointed person.

[23:19] Where can be this? Is Satan who likes meeting people privately? Yeah. He said. I am a Jew.

Born in Tarsus of Cilicia. But. I. Brought up in the city. At the feet of Gamaliel. Can you imagine? He was talking about his education. At the feet of Gamaliel.

Gamaliel taught him all. Now. If he makes reference to Gamaliel. You can tell that this guy has been to the best training. Has gone through the best training. Even. That was not. Religious training.

Or spiritual training. That was not. Before God called him. He had been. He had been trained. And he was saying that. His educational training. Is also a reference point.

For who he was in life. So those of you. Say. I don't do school. I'll just do church. Sorry. I feel sorry for you. Your future will be compromised. So.

[24:23] Mentorship. You cannot be mentored. If you are not humble. People who are not humble. They see mentorship as torment.

Instead of a mentor. It's like a tormentor. Because. You see. You need to be humble. For someone to hold your hand. Say. Go there. Go there. Do this. Stop that.

You can't do this. You can't do this. And discipleship. Is about mentorship. In spiritual things. Someone must be able to tell you. That you need to break up that relationship.

Someone must be able to tell you. That you need to redo your hair. So everybody needs a mentor.

In your career. Okay. In your career. Let's say you want to be. A medical. That's why usually. In medical school. You're supposed to go and do. Housemanship. It's another way of.

[25:21] It's mentorship. Actually. In even nursing. Yes. And teacher training. Yes. You have to go and do. And. I mean. Most of the. The top professions.

Like architecture. Yeah. Am I right. You are. Architects. You have to go and do. Some. A lawyer. You finish your. LPC. You have to now go.

And do some. Whatever. Whatever. You know what I'm talking about. Yeah. As a people. They don't want to. They finish law school. Then they go and buy a wig.

Hey. I'm going. I'm going to court. This judge. Because. I had distinction in my exams. So now I can go to court. No. It doesn't work like that.

You need mentorship. You need. You must be an apprentice. A disciple. Another word for disciple. Is an apprentice. Who is learning from a master.

[ 26:16 ] You want to do ministry. Humble yourself. Because you can read the Bible. And quote quotations. Doesn't make you a minister. Being a minister. Is not based on quotations. So humble yourself.

Stay. Serve. So you want to preach. You feel God has called you to preach. Please. It doesn't start with preaching. Preach on the streets. And bring them to church. That is preaching. Not microphone. You don't need microphone.

To show you a preacher. But. Why are they not letting me lead prayer? No. That's not where it starts from. If you want to do practice preaching. There are a lot of puppets.

All over. Everywhere on the streets. People. Single puppets. You see you might be a puppet. Preach to him. Preach to him. And let's see what your preaching can do.

If you can bring people. And get them established in church. For a long time. And more and more and more and more and more can. We can say. Okay. There's a potential. And then we can also begin to get you ready. Don't say.

[27:13] You know. They don't know how I'm anointed. I'm anointed. They should give me one day. They give me the microphone. They will be surprised. That's why you will never have the microphone. So.

Everybody needs a mentor. And wherever. You see. Mentorship helps for learning. And learning is necessary for progress.

So when you stop learning. You start dying. So we need a mentor. Especially when you are young. You know. You know. When you are young. There are a lot of things you think you know.

Later you find out that. Somebody said this. Now that I'm 60. I know the things that I thought I knew when I was 16. He said.

Now that I am 60. I know the things I thought I knew when I was 16. When you are young. You are filled with energy. So you think knowledge is based on energy.

[28:20] Gray hair. Has a lot to tell. Gray hair usually. Usually. Is a depiction of experience. You have been around a bit.

A bit. A bit longer. And interesting. Life is. It's not only one side. No.

Yeah. How many of you have seen. The. The electrocardiograph machine. Huh. So when you see.

A life support machine. The ECG. ECG. Electrocardiograph. The ECG. When you look at the. It goes like this. Yeah.

So when. When you visit somebody. And then there's a. Life support. Or there's a machine. It goes like. It goes like this. And even when you are. They are trying to check. Is it the ultrasound. Yeah.

[29:23] Or when. The heartbeat of a baby. And then sometimes. You can see the machine. Every now and then. Printed. It's an unpleasant sight.

God. That means the person. Is not feeling well. So all the times. I've been to the hospital. I'm just waiting. Sitting by somebody. Go. Let the person be well. And then the nurse. Will come and check the pulse.

And come and change. And they come and add some. Fluid. Change the. Whatever. Intravenous. Stuff. Now. It becomes an emergency.

When the thing stops. And it's done. When your life is just straight. You are dead though. Life is full of. That means that life is working.

Wow. Once it gets. Once it gets. Six feet. You are dead.

[30:19] So. The more you have lived life. The more you have seen. Difficult times. Interesting times.

And you can tell somebody. When you see these signs. Watch this. Watch this. Steady well. Take the course. No. This course is better. Do this. Don't fight the person like that. Leave them.

Don't worry. Keep going. Later on. They'll regret. You know. You need someone to speak into your life. You need someone to guide you. Because none of us is self-made.

Everybody needs an authority. And everybody needs a mentor. Your destiny is usually compromised without a mentor. Without a mentor.

You are left with torment. Without a mentor. Your life will be full of torment. Full of regrets. How many of you have had some regrets?

[31:18] And how many of you have had regrets? And you knew. If you had listened. It would have happened. It's part of life.

So. When you have mentorship. These are the bigger issues in life. There are bigger issues in life. Like what university you choose. What course. You read.

Those things. Are important. They are important. And you need some level of mentorship. Actually.

What friends you make. Can damage your life. Usually. Yeah. So you have. Your mentor reserves the right to tell you. I do not want to see you talking to that guy again.

Right? Yes. Yes. Yes. You don't like being told. What to do. But. You are too wise. Not to accept. The instructions. But if you are foolish.

[32:18] Say no. You go. Why are you telling me that? It's my life. Hey. Those who say this. It's my life. It's my life. You are very ignorant. That's why you talk like that. What you mean by your life?

The government will not even allow you to commit suicide. Think about it. You cannot be. You won't be allowed to commit suicide. Wow.

It's an offense. Yeah. Yeah. You can't be. You are not permitted. Because it's not your life. That's right. When it happens to you. It affects a lot more people. You can't be driving.

It says my car. I bought the fuel. And I paid the insurance. I can't drive anyhow I want. Uh oh. Uh oh. Wow. You are going to affect others. Other road users. Other people's lives are in danger.

If you want to kill yourself. You still cannot drive anyhow. Or you affect other people. That's life. But you know. A lot of people who don't have any proper upbringing.

[33:13] There's no authority in your life. You have been made to feel like. Well do whatever you want to do. Wow. That's your biggest down. Downfall. And your biggest.

Your biggest problem in life. Is that you were not trained to know. You need authority in your life. Someone who can. And enforce boundaries. In your life. You are not doing this.

You are not going. You can cry blood. They say still. You are not going. But I'm talking to somebody. We never get tired of hearing good.

Things that will help us. Because I actually feel I owe you so much. I feel I owe you so much. I can't afford. To have your ears.

And not help you to succeed in life. Because you look at. You are sitting here listening to me. I better help your destiny. I can't waste your time.

[34:09] Actually this is Ezra's week right. You can't be wasting time here. Something good must go in. That will. Position you. For an advantage in life.

Say amen. Honor. Right. Honor. Always make sure there is somebody in your life. You are honoring. A mother.

Some people end up in prison because they think I've been inside. It's a cool thing. It's a mad philosophy. You wouldn't know how bad it's damaged you until you grow and you want to buy a house.

You want to start a business. You want to rise above a threshold of your family. Then you realize that you hurt yourself because the system is speaking against you many years before you got here.

It's a system. Never celebrate anyone who doesn't find a problem with prison. In fact, give them distance before they corrupt your good manes.

It's a philosophy of life. Some of us, there's no way you'll be before greatness and stay there. Because you don't know how to comport yourself.

You see a great man like, let's say I meet Ag Bishop. And I say, hey, man, how are you? Hey. Hey. Ha. Ha. Then I'm talking to you.

I say, hey. Ha. Ha. Ha. Now, wow. Now, wow. Now, wow. No. There's a press protocol.

But unfortunately, I'm about to say something quite interesting. Unfortunately, sometimes your background will not prepare you for the protocols necessary for greatness.

You never know. So you appear before greatness and you butcher your destiny. Oh. Because you don't know how to talk. You don't know how to accord respect. You don't know.

I was told. I haven't met the queen yet. I was told that the royals, Prince Charles the Queen and William and Kate and the royals, when they say they are coming to your school or your company or something, they know the way they line all of them up everybody's thumbs.

[ 37:21 ] And when he gets there, you don't try to shake your hand. You don't do that. The women, you just, you know, your royal highness. Or the men, even some men.

You don't. Who dare you? How dare you take your hand? Shake me. No, you don't do that. If he offers to shake you, wow. Then you do it. Else, keep your hand there. These are protocols.

And what they do with their palace life is people like Prince William, Prince Harry, and all those guys, they are taught palace protocols. So when Prince William is going to meet a president or somebody, everything they brief you.

In this country, this is how they do. This is how they do. This is how you do. Women do this. Men do this. This is how you go about. When you get to the queen, when you are addressing the queen, you have to say your majesty or your royal highness.

These are things that you'll be taught by. You're coming from a ghetto. This is... No, I'm honest. Some of you, you know you were born in the ghetto. You know it. You know you were born in the ghetto. But the good news is that you will stay in the ghetto.

[38:27] That's the good news. Say, say, okay. I don't think I've ever said this in K-P2. But today I'll say it. In 1 Samuel 2, verse 8 and 9, it's our covenant scripture.

Our covenant scripture. When this church was about to start, this is a scripture God gave me. The platform on which the church is built, the scriptural platform, is that this scripture in 2 Corinthians chapter 12, verse 9.

This scripture, it says that God raises the poor from the dust and lifts the beggar from the hardship. So it's not you.

It's a God. God can do it. You are poor. You are in the dust. But God raises them. Amen. That's why we don't mind people without class coming. God will lift them and give them class.

Say, God raises the poor from the dust and lifts the beggar from the ash heap to set them among ash. All right.

[39:36] Let's do some grammar here. God raises who? So who are we talking about? Is it only the poor? Two people here.

Two groups of people here. The poor and the beggar. Come on. Let's go again. Two groups of people. The poor and the beggar. What does God do to the poor and the beggar?

He raises them. So God raises. The poor and the beggar. So why don't you look at the text very carefully. He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the beggar from the ash heap to set them among the poor.

Now, the poor. Okay. The poor. The beggar. The beggar. The beggar. Not beggars. Princes.

So he raises them. That's, these are the princes. Princes. But you are not a prince. You are born one.

[40:39] You don't apply to be a prince. Do you? No. No. But, when someone works with God enough, the God that makes people.

By the time you guys like have a conference and be chatting and like, yeah. By the time you realize, stay there. You realize, yeah, it keeps going on. And then you're wondering, ah.

What's that? What's he doing there? But he's not a prince. He's originally, he's from the ghetto. What's he doing there? The answer is God.

And watch this. And set them among princes and make them inherit thrones. Throne of glory. So the way you look at them, the princes are reigning.

They are also reigning. And the princes look at them. And the princes say, he's not less than us. In fact, they go to him for advice. They say, oh, this fellow prince. But it is the working of God.

[41:40] And then God takes the beggar as well. And the poor and the beggar. And sets them amongst princes. So then, when you come, your background is not a problem.

It's where God is taking you to that we are excited. God raises the poor from the dust. And lifts the beggar from the hardship.

And set them among princes. And make them inherit the throne of glory. Why? For the pillars of the earth are the laws. And he sets the world upon them. He can promote anyone he wants to promote.

And demote anyone he wants to demote. Shout hallelujah. Hallelujah. Hallelujah. In the book of Psalms, I think 96 or 95.

It said, promotion does not come from the east. From the east, from the west, from the south. Ah, he left the north. North is like top. Promotion, Psalm 95 or Psalm 96.

[ 42:40 ] Or 70. Oh, 75. For promotion cometh neither from the east, nor from the south. Why? Because promotion comes from God above.

So, this is just to explain the ghetto life and your ghetto background. Yeah. Yeah. Your ghetto background is not an indication that you can't go high.

That is even the beauty about God getting involved in your life. That people later will look at you and they can't trace where you are to where you are coming from. It's like, how could you come from such a place and look at where you are?

Hallelujah. Hallelujah. Please clap for the princes. When they look at you, it's like your current glorious position is not traceable to your miserable background.

Amen. And it's like there's a missing piece. How? How? There's no road here. Yes. But you knew you were born. How did you arrive here? That's right. The road, the bridging gap is caught.

[43:50] Wow. God. But you must first admit that you are a ghetto boy. Yes. And then humble yourself. But God raises, please, don't, thank you Jesus.

Stop, stop, stop feeling sorry for your background. What can you do about your parents? How can you do about your skin color? What can you do about your gender?

What can you do about how you were raised? It's in the past. You can't do anything about it. There's not much you can do about your past. Please. I beg you.

And don't let the devil use your past to rob your future. A lot has happened in your past. But stop, stop focusing on the past. Don't try going forward looking back. You'll definitely fall or you'll stumble.

You have to keep looking forward. What has happened? Let it be in the past. And lift your eyes and keep going. And keep going. And keep going.

[44:55] And have faith in God. Have faith in God. Trust God. Because you are a great person and a champion in the making. The truth is the world is yet to see your kind of champion.

Because with all what you have been through. And you are still standing. Hallelujah. Hallelujah. Hallelujah. You've been through so much.

And you are still standing. So you have to have this philosophy of life that knows that if God be for us. Philosophy is different.

Philosophy is in different ways. When I talk about philosophy, I'm talking about worldview. Your mindset about marriage. Your mindset about girls.

Your mindset about boys. Your mindset about things of God. Your mindset about money. Some people, their philosophy of money will end up in prison. Because they will do anything for money.

[45:54] They will do anything for money. So even when promotion is about to come, they will destroy it because of greed. The Bible says that a man without self-control is like a city without war.

Everybody can. No border control. No border control. If you don't have, he said, yeah. He who has, whoever has no rule over his own spirit is like a city broken down without walls.

No border control. Anybody at all get into your life, checks out. Comes in. Drive through. Drive through. So we should have a very large heart to accommodate people to help them.

And without endorsing their wrong behavior. Their destructive path. We can't endorse it. But whoever you are, wherever you are coming from, we have a large heart to accept it because God still has planned for you.

God is in the business of recycling people. In church, it's like recycling business. Sometimes somebody asks me, what do you do? I say, I'm in the recycling business.

[47:07] Or what do you recycle? Human beings. So you can tell, I've just let you in on my philosophy of life.

Sometimes I speak very strong because I'm trying to help people to understand the principles of God. I have a very large heart for anybody and everybody. Because God loves people and God cares about people.

We have time for you. Just that if you don't have time for us, we can use our time for some important things. How can we help you? How can the doctors help you if you don't go to hospital? When you come, humble yourself.

Admit you need help. Take away the facade. You have put up a facade. Put up a bold face, you know. You know what I mean, man? But you know you need help.

Sometimes you can't sleep. You're afraid in life. There's no hope for the future. Sometimes you feel like even if I die, I don't mind. No! You won't sit down for that to happen. You want to give you a reason for living so much that you enjoy, you feel life is meaningful.

[48:15] And you are not ready to check out. Life is meaningful. I have a hat for people. Because some of you, when I look at your face, I can tell there's greatness.

Maybe you might not even believe in yourself. Yeah. Because of historic events in your life. You might not believe. And you don't even know what it means to be great.

Because everybody around your life is in the ghetto. Yeah. Everybody has ended up in prison and messed their lives out. Being killed, being shot, and murdered, and murdering, and stealing.

And it's like you are coming from an atmosphere of turmoil. But let me end on this. Think about this.

With all you have been through, and all that has happened in your life. If God flips it, and they begin to do well. Don't you think your story will be a nice story to write?

[49:17] I'm telling you a very beautiful story. Because of the ups and downs. If we trace, or we read your biography, it can be turned into a blockbuster.

Your biography, because of where you are coming from. And where God has taken you to. What? Everybody's got a story to tell. But your own is very special.

That's why you don't have to be crying over your past. Lift up your eyes. Put your faith in God. Love God. Submit yourself to mentorship. And have a healthy philosophy of life. And know how to honour people that have to be honoured.

And see if you will not get to the top. It's the simplest way to get to the top. If you receive something. God bless you for listening to this powerful message.
