

# I Am Done With This Place

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[0:00] Thank you for tuning into this message by David Entry. Every true revival is a product of the strong preaching of God's word.! May you receive a word from this message that will spark a revival in you.

Today's reading, verse 15, is that call upon me in the day of trouble and I will deliver you. And thou shall go over me in the day of trouble. Is that I want to deliver you, but I want you to do something. I want you to call upon me. When you call on him, he answers. Hallelujah. We are about to get into a time of prayer. Anything that poses concern for you, in this time of fasting, is the best time to push and call on his name and look for him. Praise the Lord. So, we want to pray. We are going to pray and call on the name of God regarding a particular matter. Call on the name of the Lord!

[1:08] One of the things I found out, those of you who are not married, if you don't want to fall into temptation, you pray ahead of it, it won't happen. When you pray, God, help me to stay away from fornication.

I will never fornicate. I will never fornicate. I will never lie to my pastor. I will never... Lord, help me. Yes. Yes. When you pray that prayer, God answers it. God will save you. He said, He said, call upon me and I will... I will deliver you.

Tell somebody, God will deliver you. God will deliver you. From gossip. From gossip. From lying. From falling. From trouble. From shame. From disgrace. From satanic traps.

God will deliver you in the name of Jesus. Isaiah chapter 55 verse 6, it says, Call on the animal while he's near.

Call on him while he's near. This is the good time as we are fasting. Call upon God concerning a matter. Do you understand what I'm saying? Call on God. Stop feeling guilty about what has happened.

[2:22] You can't do anything about it though. Satan can use it. But God will not use it if you can call on him. And you can't do anything about what has happened in your past. It doesn't matter who knows it.

It doesn't matter who is talking about it. May God put a rat in their mouth. Leave them alone. And you concentrate about your future. So this is the time.

Call upon him while he's near. This time of the fasting, you can tell. We are meeting every day. Something seems to be working for you. Use this moment.

Call upon him regarding your health, your marriage, your family, your situation, your career, your finances, your ministry. Hey! Call upon him.

Call upon him. He says that in Psalm 145 verse 18. In Psalm 145 verse 18, he said, For the Lord is near to who?

[3:20] To all. How many? All. All. For the same Lord is rich unto all who call upon him. I don't know what you need God to do for you.

I don't know what you need God to intervene on the behalf. But listen, God answers prayers. He said, call upon him while he's near. Call upon him while he's near. For he's near to all those who call upon him.

Do you know what God does? If you jump towards God, God runs towards you. Anytime you jump towards God, he runs fast coming towards you. He just desires us to call upon him.

Come close. He said, draw close to God and he will draw close to you. Now, when I say great exodus, you will say, I'm done with this place. You know, somebody's changing levels.

In Acts chapter 12, verse 7 and verse 8, an angel appeared in the prison. How about that?

Shadahaya. Peter was about to die the next day.

[4:30] An angel appeared in the prison and light shone in the prison. And the angel smote him on the side and said, rise up. Saying, arise quickly. And his chain fell off.

Look at the next verse. And the angel gave him instructions. The angel said to him, get thyself, get thyself and bind up thy sandals.

You are going to be sleeping in your shoes. I know you didn't get it. Tell somebody, put on your shoes. Put on your shoes.

Unless you are not ready. But if you are ready, you are putting on your shoes. Why? Because I'm done with this place. I'm moving to a better place. I'm moving to a bigger place.

Hey, I'm done with this place. I am done with this place. I'm moving to something better. I'm moving on to something bigger. Shadahaya. Shadahaya.

[5:29] Shadahaya. Great exodus. I'm moving to a place. In the book of Psalm, it said, Psalm 52, verse 11, you shall exalt my horn like that of the unicorn.

I shall be anointed with. He said, when he said, he will exalt my horn. The horn is the strongest part of the animal.

Animals like rhino. Some of the rhinos are so strong. They are more dangerous than lions. A rhino can lift a lion heavily and throw the lion.

Because a normal rhino can weigh about six tons. Some of you don't understand what it means.

And he's able to carry weight with the horn, which is about three tons.

So half his weight, the strength is in the horn. And he says that, you shall exalt my horn. You shall exalt my horn.

[6:37] You shall exalt my horn. You shall exalt my horn. And I will be anointed. Last. Listen. It's 20. Leave it.

Sometimes you must leave them in 2025. Great exodus. I can hear you. Great exodus. Great exodus. I can hear you.

Prophecy to yourself. Great exodus. Get your shoes on. Get your shoes on.

Get your shoes on. Because you are done with this place. You are done with this place. You are done with this place. Something bigger is coming.

Something better is coming. Days of shame are over. Days of afflictions are over. Shout yes. In today's Bible reading in Psalm 50.

[7:42] Verse 5 says that, gather my sins together unto me. It's not everybody. Is that those, those who, that have made a covenant with me, I sacrifice.

You've sacrificed your convenience. You've sacrificed your comfort. You have sacrificed your food. Giving dangerously. Some are giving to the work of God.

So prophetically. And others are also, not just prophetically, but blessing others. Sacrificially.

Something that you have treasured for so long.

Say, if it must be from God, there must be a step of sacrifice one way or the other. Some of us, the things we are dealing with, we are believing medical science to help us.

If you are trusting God, trust Him properly. Because medical science can deal with demonic hijacking. It says that, gather my people, those who have made a covenant with me by sacrifice.

[8:52] You see how sacrifice is important to God? Anytime you are going to make a demand from God, make sure you have a sacrifice history. There must be a historic sacrifice before you make current demand.

So a lot of sacrifices that we do have gone into the archives. Have gone into divine storage for the day that you need to make a demand on heaven.

Look at what he said in verse 10. For every beast of the forest is mine, and the cattle upon the thousand hills. I know all the fowls of the mountains, and the wild beasts of the field are mine.

If I were hungry, I would not tell you. God said if I was hungry, I don't need anything from you now. For the world is mine. And the food, everything inside the world, I don't need you to help me.

That's what he's trying to say. Will I eat the flesh of bulls or drink the black? God doesn't eat. God doesn't spend money. He doesn't spend money.

[10:03] So if he's putting on your heart to sow a seed, it's not because he's looking for... That's what he means. If he's putting on your heart

to do something, sacrifice was always something valuable that leaves you. Don't forget that. Will I eat the flesh of bulls or drink the blood of bulls? I don't need it. So why am I demanding it? Why am I saying my people who have made a covenant with me by sacrifice? Why have I distinguished those who have covenanted with me by sacrifice from the rest? Is it because I'm hungry? Is it because I depend on the money or depend on the food or depend on the cattle?

It's a cattle on the thousand hills is mine. So the fact that I depend or I use sacrifices is not for my own benefit. One of the clearest evidence of sacrifice is faith talk.

God doesn't need our sacrifices. We need a connection with him via our sacrifices. God doesn't need our sacrifices.

[11:08] But we need a connection with him. How? Through our sacrifices. A certain unforgettable, undeniable connection. And I see that coming to somebody.

Look at verse 14. Offer unto God thanksgiving and pay thy vows unto the most high. What vow have you made?

And what do you know is in your heart that God, if you spare me from going to prison, I will never miss church again. It says that offer unto God thanksgiving and pay thy vows unto the most high. And we have been jumping to verse 15 without respecting verse 14. Verse 14 is the condition for verse 15. What does verse 15 say?

Verse 15 says that end. You have outstanding vows you haven't paid and you are calling. Most people erase their hand.

[12:10] And they start with call upon him. No, he never said call upon him. He said you pay, give thanksgiving and pay your vows. And then call upon him.

I told you, even for them to leave Egypt, Exodus, they have to slaughter a lamb. Yeah. You are busy wearing your shoes without having any slaughter behind you.

Pharaoh will catch you. Oh, I see you moving forward. Verse 16.

Verse 16 says that, But unto the wicked God said, What hast thou to do to declare my statutes? And that thou shouldest take my covenant in your...

You won't take my... The things I'm saying, you won't take it to yours. He said, what hast thou to do? Now look at what he said. Verse 17. Seeing that you heard instructions. You heard instructions and casted my words behind you.

[13:16] So, after all, I'm done with this place. Please, I've heard that. Yeah. You cast it behind you. A prophetic word has come. Something you know God is saying, he casts it behind you.

It's very funny the things God is saying about the wicked. He said, when somebody is stealing, you say, yeah, that's okay. New King James will explain it better. Yes. Yeah, you consent.

When you saw a thief, you consented with him. And you partake with adulteress. Yeah. Yeah. So, you are conniving and lying. God is saying, these are the wicked.

These are what they do. But the last verse says that, whosoever offers praise, glorifies God. And to him who orders his conversation in lifestyle arise, I will show him the salvation of the Lord. So, when you are doing what is right, God said, I will show you.

I will display my salvation to you. Yeah. So, you are not doing it for pastor. You are not doing it for brother. You are not doing it for anybody. You are doing it for yourself. Amen.
