Endure To The End

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[0:00] Welcome. Thank you for choosing to listen to another faith-building message by Pastor David Entry. Faith comes by hearing and by hearing the Word of God.

May your knowledge of Jesus Christ increase as you listen. Be blessed. Hebrews chapter 10, verse 35, 36, 37.

Verse 35 says that, Cast not away, therefore, your confidence, which has a great recompense of reward. That way, recompense also can be rendered compensation.

You know, you can't have compensation without previous losses. So that means that your confidence will cause you some losses, right?

Before you think about compensation. Your faith, your confidence, okay, you see, what version is that? Amplify, thank you. It says that, Do not, therefore, fling away your fearless confidence, for it carries a great and glorious, I like that one, great and glorious compensation.

[1:10] Right? Don't miss the word compensation. Compensation means being given something in line with what you have lost.

So they are giving you something to appease you and to make up for what was lost. And here, he says that our confidence, so embedded or implicit or implied in this text means that your confidence will cost you some losses.

But it's okay because those losses have been factored in your reward coming. Do you have to do that? Do you think it's like you are employed to work for a company?

And you have to drive around from maybe company to go or from city to city, town to town, and working for the company. And you need your own car. And let's say your salary is in a month, they are paying you 5,000.

Okay, so 5K a month. And they say, does it? No, they have to tell you, they are paying you 5K a month, but your fuel and the usage of your car too, they will pay you for that.

So it will be factored in your end of month salary. So what they are paying you is not just, they will pay you that and they will factor your losses as well.

So anytime you do something for the company, whatever you lose must not be at your expense. In 1 Corinthians 9, it says, I think verse 7, it says that who goes to war at their own expense?

You can do things for God at your own expense. It's in your Bible. It's just that you don't know. Because we read 1 Corinthians recently. You didn't see it. 1 Corinthians 9. It says, who goes to war at his own expense?

No. Who plants a vineyard and does not eat the fruit? So don't mind those who say that. But why are you giving this to the church? Why are you giving this to the pastor? You are the vineyard of the church.

You have a vineyard. And God has used the church to bless you. So when you give your tithe to the church, you are not doing anything too much. Those of you who have not planned to tithe this month, I'm telling you, you are not doing anything too much.

You are just doing what is reasonable. Yeah. So it says that who plants a vineyard and does not eat of the fruit thereof? Why should I be praying and believing God, fasting and praying for your marriage?

And then when you get the marriage, you become a problem for the church and you are no more around. No. I am. When I'm praying and if God blesses you, you actually use your marriage and family life to build God's work.

Amen. When God blesses you with a good job, when you get a good job, do you know how it sounds? It should sound in the spirit. The church has got a good job. Wow. So it's not you.

It's the church. It's not you. It's the house of God. So it says that who plants a vineyard and does not eat of the fruits thereof? When you plant it, you must know that you are about to eat of the fruits, its fruit.

Or who ters the flock and does not drink the milk of the flock? Milk of the flock will also go to the one who is tending the flock. And this is not saying, I'm telling you that you don't go to war at your own expense.

[4:33] So when you take steps of faith, when you walk with God and you do what is spiritual, any losses that come through your spiritual activities, Bible says that it will be factored in the reward time.

Hallelujah. Do not cast away your great confidence. Your confidence is your trust in God. That is why you are doing this fasting. You are doing this fasting and then your very good friend said that, you know, it's my, I want to go for lunch with you.

And he said, no, I'm fasting. He said, if you don't go, then forget it. We are no more friends that loss that you sustain because of your fasting, your pursuit towards God. When the reward time comes, it will be factored in the reward.

Amen. Yeah. That's what it means. Yeah. You can, when you fast and you lose relationships, when you do the things of God and you lose relationships, God has a way of compensate.

He says, he has a great, it has a great reward or compensation, recompense.

Yeah. He has a great recompense, reward of, do not cast it away because it comes with a great reward. It comes with great compensation.

It comes with great recompense of, that's the word, recompense of reward. I like the KJs. He said, it has, it has, your, your confidence has two things, your confidence in God will always have.

Are you ready for this? Two things your confidence in God will always have. The, the one that the Bible mentions is the obvious one. The other one is implicit, is hidden in confidence.

What is it? Losses. But the Bible is telling you the end is not the losses that we speak in. It's the reward that we speak at the end. Amen. So do not cast away.

You are beginning to work in faith. You are doing well. You are doing well. Don't tie your faith. Oh, don't tie your faith to instant results. No. Don't tie your faith.

[6:39] So I'm believing God for that job and I didn't get a job. So I've lost faith. No. No. No. Don't tie your faith to instant results. Tie your faith to Christ.

Who is the beginner and the finisher of the faith. And so at the end of the faith, there are many other things that are waiting. Watch this. There are people who have walked by faith or tried to believe God and have suffered some losses.

But unfortunately, they did not endure to the end. Matthew chapter 10 verse 22. It says that he that endures to the end. To the end.

To the end. He that endures. We will come back to Hebrew very soon. But he, Matthew chapter 10 verse 22. It said, and ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake.

But he that endures to the end shall be saved. Amen. So it's not this. Oh, Jesus.

[7:37] It's not only he who calls on the name of the Lord. It's he who. You know, I was teaching the other time. And I told you salvation. In fact, yesterday's message. Salvation is, it takes a whole lifetime.

Salvation is just not an instant. Salvation has stages. Stages. So he that he who, the Bible says that whoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. That's the first one.

But this endurance who will endure to the end is the other salvation we are talking about. Okay. He that shall endure to the end shall be saved. And I can guarantee you the first salvation is not as sweet as the last one.

The last one is far better. It's far better. Because you got the first salvation to prep you, to prepare you, to prime you, to program you, to get you ready for the real salvation that is coming.

That is why in 1 Peter 1 verse 13, I like that scripture so much. It has become one of my favorite scriptures for this season. It says that set your hope on the grace that is to be revealed or grace that is to come at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

[8:47] Get up the loins of your mind. Oh, my God. My God. I am. Therefore, get up the loins of your mind. Make up your mind.

Be sober and hope to the end for the grace. Oh, grace is coming. For the grace that is to be brought to you and the revelation. There is something better.

But it will come to you if you don't make up your mind. Listen, the faith walk will come with some challenges to you. Yes. I don't know how many of you have believed God to pass an exam and you failed before.

You feel like God. Why? God, this interview. I sowed a seed. I did everything. I sowed my seed.

I did this. I did this. How? How God? God, you have let me know. Listen, if you cry because something went wrong when you believe in God, you are not the only one who has done it.

[9:44] You have not done anything wrong, Bessie. Right. But finish the crying. Finish the crying and get up your mind that this doesn't matter. I still trust God. God said, even though he slays me, I will trust him.

Even though he slays me, I will trust him. So you have to make up your mind. If God, you know, stops. One of the things that I just know and I enjoy is when you, you know, roadworks.

Yes. When they are doing roadworks. Yes. And then, you know, that temporary traffic, like man by human beings. Yes. Yes. So much traffic. And every car is coming. Just when you're so glad that the guy says stop.

Come on. Yes. Why? I don't like that at all. So I'm praying that this guy, don't stop me. You let me pass. I'm in a hurry. I'm getting late.

Let me pass. Sometimes you want to zoom past quickly. Yes. Sometimes you want to zoom past quickly. And they won't even. You see, you have to get up the noise of your mind. When they stop you, don't worry.

You'll be okay. Okay. You will be okay. So sometimes you may not get what you wanted to get. You may not get what you wanted to get the way you wanted to get it.

But if you can get up your mind and be super and hope to the end, you will see that you have actually not lost. God has prepared you for this moment.

Sometimes when you don't see answers the way you want, it's not because God is late. It's just because you are early. Wow. Wow. It's a way.

Wow. You are early. You see, so you have to set up your mind, make up your mind that, okay, let me show you something.

The problem is timing. Oh. He says that he that endures to the end. Say the end. The end. Is somebody receiving something at all?

[11:47] I have received it. He said, he that endures to the end shall be saved. Watch this. So now, but the problem is your definition of the end.

Wow. Wow. You thought the end is the end of this month. Oh my God. Oh my God. Oh my God. Hey. Who told you your year is the same as my year?

Uh-huh. My year, according to the time I was born, June 19th. My year started on 19th of June. That's it. That's it. So when they said that by the end of this year, you are thinking by the end of 2020.

Wow. That's it. By the end. Oh. By the end of that year, you are in. Yeah. Ba-ba-ba-ba. So do not judge the timing of God.

Sometimes it is your timing that is wrong. Let me show you something in the scriptures. In the book of John, chapter 7, verse 6, verse 7, verse 8, John, Jesus' brothers came to him.

[12:46] They didn't believe in him anyway. You know they didn't believe in him. They came and then they said unto him, look at the verse before, verse 5 actually, verse 5. They said unto him, for his brothers didn't believe in him.

They told him, go, go, so that you can get more disciples, verse 3, verse 4, go to Judea so that more people can believe in you. And look at his answer, verse 6. He told them that, verse 6, please, let's go to verse 6.

He says that, then he says, answer them, answer and said unto them, my time is not yet come. Ah. But your time is always ready. Ah. So that one, who is telling me, I believe God, I believe God, he hasn't done it.

Whose time are you using? Ah. Ah. Whose time are you using? That's why you think it doesn't happen. What do you mean by it hasn't happened? He said that this is for an appointed time.

Ah. Don't it tarish. Wait for Habakkuk. Don't it tarish. Wait for it. For it shall speak. At the end, it shall speak. For at the end, it shall speak.

[13:45] In the book of Habakkuk. It says that the vision, write the vision. Make it plain. That he that read it, it will run. For the vision is for an appointed time. For the vision is yet for an appointed time.

Oh my God. It's yet for an appointed time. But at the end, it shall speak. And shall not lie. How do you define the end? The problem is the way you are defining the end.

Your end is not God's end. When God's end comes, everything shall be the way God has said it. Don't run ahead of God. You thought God is late. But I submit to you, you might be early.

Your timing is early. Pastor Harker, you say, look, I'm 39 and I'm not yet married. I've been waiting. I've been waiting for the past seven years. It does not matter. God's timing.

Look at Zachariah, the father of John the Baptist. If God has followed their timing, John the Baptist would have had the privilege of introducing Jesus. But Jesus was coming at a certain time.

[14:42] So God intentionally had to look like God was not hearing their prayers. They were praying for a child. They were praying for a child. But the good news is they never stopped praying.

But the good news is they never stopped relating to God. But the good news is they never stopped believing in God. And at the appointed time, 15 months before Jesus was born, the angel visited them because their son had to be six months older than Jesus.

Because he is the one who is supposed to use her. The Bible said they were about to give birth. They were about to give birth to the greatest of all the prophets in the Old Testament.

But they didn't know. If John the Baptist had been born one month earlier, that would have been God's timing. He would have missed that privilege. I'm telling you, God's timing is the best. God's timing and he who shall endure to the end.

What's end? The end of God's timing. The end of God's timing. The end of God's timing. Don't be distracted by the timings of men. Don't be distracted by natural timings.

[15:40] Don't look at the movement of the sun. Don't look at the movement of the moon. No, you don't need that. You have to keep your eye on God. Look unto Jesus. Look unto Jesus.

Look unto Jesus. Can I show you a scripture? In Matthew chapter 16. Let's read Matthew chapter 16, verse 1, verse 2, verse 3, verse 4. Jesus told them something about timing.

Hallelujah. The Pharisees, also with the Sadducees, came and tempted, and tempting, desired him that he would show them a sign from heaven.

Is that not some of you, oh, your fasting is doing? Oh, your fasting, God, if you are with me. Wow. Wow. Sometimes God will intentionally not answer those kind of baby, baby kind of prayers.

Wow. If any time you say, God, please do this and let it be. The one that is even bad is when you want God to do it for others to see. You are the one to advise him when and where he should put his name on the billboard.

[16:45] He hasn't got enough experience. No. No. You just have to say, that will be done. That will be done.

Jesus said it. He said, not just if it's possible, let things change now. But sometimes when a woman is going out with a guy or something, and he comes to tell me, Pastor, when somebody is going for an interview for a big job, you can tell this one, if I get the job, Pastor, if I get this job, it will change a lot for me if I get this job.

And please, I want you to pray for the way my heart goes into it. And I pray for my heart. But always, sometimes I add it. God, let your will prevail. It doesn't mean this job is not for the person.

I really want the person to get the job. But maybe, maybe, I leave room for God. Much as we want it so bad, I leave room for God in spite of how bad I want it and how bad that person wants it.

I just leave room for God to be God and Lord over our prayer topics. That's right. God is not God. It's you who are God. And you are commanding God.

[17:54] God, you have to do this. If you don't do this, I'm giving you an ultimatum. I'm giving you by next Friday. Okay, this is the last time I'm doing this fasting. I'm doing this fasting for the last time. If you don't do it, God, you see, you make God not do it.

If you don't do it, I won't go to church again. If you don't go to church again. If you don't do it, even if my leader calls me, I won't pick it again because I'm upset. I'm upset. When you hear someone say, I'm upset with God.

Sometimes, listen. Sometimes it feels like that and it's okay. If you're a human being, there are times you feel like that. You feel, Eli, Eli, why, my God, my God, why have you forsaken me?

You will feel it, though. You will feel it. In Psalm 22, verse, somewhere there. He said in verse 2, Eli, Eli, Lamach, Sabachthani. Jesus had to come and repeat it on the cross. He was so beaten.

He was so, he felt so abandoned and rejected. He cried, Eli, Eli, Lamach, Sabachthani. Why do you think you won't have to cry that?

[18:59] Wow. Wow. Wow. Sometimes, listen. Sometimes, the closer you walk with God, there will be instances in your life when it feels like, where is God?

Yeah. Some of you know what I'm talking about. Yes. I might be talking to somebody right now. Yeah. Yeah. Yeah. Yeah. That moment, right now. God, so where are you?

God, so where are you? God, why? Why? I've done everything. That is even what makes me frustrated. Wow. I've done everything.

I have fasted. I have sowed seeds. I've even sowed my wig. I have. I've sowed.

When they asked me to sow seeds, I didn't just sow the seed. I added the fruit. Wow. The whole fruit. The seed. Pastor, Father, God, I've done everything.

[20:02] I've forgiven her. I've forgiven him. I even went low and went to say I'm sorry. I've done everything. Father, why? Why? It's okay.

It's okay. It's okay. Just shed some tears before God. When you see other people, it's well. Don't cast away your confidence. Cast not away your confidence, for it has a great recompense of reward.

Yes. Yes. So they came to Jesus and they said, go to whatever, your hometown. And Jesus said, for you, every time is your time.

But for me, it's not like that. John chapter 7. Look at verse 8. Thank you, Jesus. Verse 8. Go up.

Go ye up unto this feast. I go not yet unto this feast. For my time is not yet full come. He was very conscious of divine timing.

[21:10] So even though it was time for everybody to go to the feast, he knew it wasn't his divine timing. Wow. My time has not come. I know we always say my time has come, which is good faith.

Yeah. No, no, no. It's good to say, if you believe that this is your season, say my time has come. My time has come. Wow. Very fun. Yes. That is what anyone who has confidence in God says.

Yes. Yes. Okay. But as you say that, if you, even though you believed it and it didn't show up, don't say God has let you down. Yes. Because maybe when you said my time has come, God meant something else.

Maybe God was talking about next week. Right. But your spirit is connecting to God. So you thought it's now. Don't worry. It's not wrong to believe it's now. Yeah. Only to realize that God meant that.

Let those who laugh, let them keep laughing. But definitely, he said, the vision is for an appointed time. For it shall surely come to pass. At the end, it shall speak. At the end, it shall speak.

[22:16] It shall not lie. It tarries. Wait for me. Because it shall surely come to pass. It will not tarry. Did you see that? Have you noticed that? Listen. He said, don't eat tarries.

So the first tarrying is in your eyes. Yeah. You are waiting by tarrying. Tarrying, those of you who don't know what tarrying means. Tarrying means that it delays. Yeah. Okay. Tarrying means delay.

So when you are talking to somebody, you can say, I'm tarrying. Yeah. Don't eat tarries. He said, don't eat tarries.

Wait for it. Okay. So he says that. Let me read it again. For the vision is yet for an appointed time. But at the end, it shall speak. And not lie.

Don't eat tarries. Wait for it. Why? Why should you? Because it will surely come. That's why you have to wait for it. And then he says that it will not tarry. That means when God's timing comes, nothing, nothing delays one minute.

[23:13] Sure. Sure. Have you seen a child who has stayed in the womb for 12 months before?

Even though 12 months will be in a whole year and maybe you will grow better. He said he stayed in the womb too so long.

So he grew more. He grew bigger. No. He does not change your date of birth. Your date of birth, it tells you a lot about you. Wow.

Tells you a lot about you so long as God's programming and timing is complete. Because you can't choose your date of birth. Yeah. Yeah. Yeah. You can't choose. I know people plan everything.

And still, it's subject. It's very subjective. Yeah. It's very subjective. Wow. So you can't plan your... When the natural God's timing comes, it shall come to pass.

[24:10] Let me finish the Matthew chapter 6. Is someone learning something at all? Yes. We are learning. We are learning. It's a blessing. Matthew chapter 16. He says that the Pharisees and the Sadducees, desired him to show him as them as time because they are fasting.

Because they are praying. Okay. You, God, do it. If you don't do it, God, please don't give God an ultimatum. Okay? When you give God an ultimatum, it delays the reaction, the response. Just learn how to say, Lord, let your will be done.

Wow. I trust you. I'm going through a lot, but... Let your will be done. Let your... Okay. That's okay. Because the Bible says we have a high priest that is touched by the feelings of what you are going through.

It's touched by the feelings of our infirmities. Yes. That means... Yeah. The way you feel about your challenges, it touches our high priest Jesus. And remember, he's the one interceding for you.

It touches him. That's why in 1 Peter 1, I think verse 5 and verse 6. Verse 5 talks about, if there need be. You see? Verse 6, rather. Look at verse 6.

[25:15] Verse 6 is that wherein ye greatly rejoice. Though now for a season, if there need be.
There need be what? Ye are in heaviness. So he didn't say you go through temptation.

He said you are in heaviness. The problem is the heaviness, not the temptation. Wow. Come on. Wow. Ye are in heaviness. But the heaviness is brought by the temptation. There are some challenges that don't bring heaviness on you.

They don't bring... Maybe you went for one interview, but you didn't get it. And you were not bothered. It's okay. It's okay. But not when maybe you're driving and then something might go happen.

And then you hear that you have to rush your feet to call your friend. It's something. I mean, it's because you're starting a business with you. You're going and... Yeah, that's a major... It brings a lot of heaviness. Some things don't bring heaviness.

So sometimes the challenge is not the problem. It's the heaviness. And he says that if need be, you are...

[26:15] Listen, this is Christianity. You rejoice greatly at the same time you are going through heaviness. Okay. Yeah. It's like you are a conundrum. You are a mystery to people who watch you.

Because they know you are going through a lot. But they see you smiling and rejoicing at the same time. You are not rejoicing about your problem. You are rejoicing about your future. You are rejoicing about your inheritance.

You are rejoicing about what is ahead of you. I see that in somebody's testimony. Yeah. Yeah. Yeah. Turning your situation wrong. Yes. Yes.

Yes. Yes. So. So. Now let's finish the Matthew. So we can quote. We can close. Matthew chapter 16, let's look at the next verse.

The Leo. Jesus said unto them. When. It is evening you see it to be fair. Weather. Many news. Yes. Yes. when it is evening you say it will be fair weather let's go to NIV that's even a bit simpler because of water he replied when evening comes you say it will be fair weather for the sky is red because that means the sky is clear so it's fine look at the NIVs verse 3 and in the morning today it will be storming for the sky is red and overcast you know how to interpret the appearance of the sky but you cannot interpret the signs of your times verse 4 a wicked and industrial generation look for a miraculous sign but now we give it to the Jonah no because you have tied your life to physical occurrences but you must think about the timings of God you must be able to read the timings of God come on you must be able to cast your mind on the timings of God

God has his own timing that's right never forget this God has his own timing so what pastor then why don't we sit and wait no it happens through prayer and fasting and perseverance okay but the point is that as you are persevering there is the propensity for you to overcast or cast your project your timing differently from God's timing okay okay I know what somebody's asking so pastor can I plan and thinking that my own is next year but maybe God had the plan this year why not yes especially when it comes to sacrificing obeying God and leaving that boyfriend you may say I'll do it next year you may say I'm trying to finish my exam when I finish my exam I'll but you know God has given you an instruction you know God has given you an instruction I'm trying to save to buy a house so when I save and I buy my house then I'll start tithing ah so you see you've got the wrong timing you've got the wrong timing when it comes to obeying God it is prompt human beings will naturally not postpone opportunities so we only postpone and get the timing wrong most of the time when it comes to the fulfillment of God's purpose through his demand on us so we know you're supposed to be waking up at 6am to pray but you're saying

I'll do it at 7 I believe God is telling me 7 I believe I'm trying to I'm trying to God's timing may be 7 so let me work with 7 but meanwhile God's timing is 6 and he will prompt it he will prompt you there that shall endure to the end now when you use the word endure that means you are going through something you only endure when you are going through something that is most or is a bit inconvenient so they that shall people are hating you but you are still enduring to the end you lose a job because you are Christian endure to the end you fail the interview they didn't give you the job because you are not a smoker endure to the end they want someone who will be smoking with them at break time lunch break or smoking break to go and be gossiping but you can't do that so they don't like you no problem endure to the end because your confidence has a great recompense of reward just that maintain your purity with God you thought he's a Christian guy because he plays drum in his church but when he came into your life anytime you bring

Bible topic he's not interested and every every conversation must end in sex romance and romance and gazing every conversation every conversation is drenched in erotomania I want to encourage you your timing is in God he said it shall surely come to pass and he shall not tarry that's when it's God's time Galatians 4.4 in the fullness of time God sent forth his son under a bone under the law God sent forth his son made of the bone of the woman of the okay God sent forth his son made of a woman under the law he was born of a woman he said to God sent forth his son at the what at the fullness of time the Greek word for that is kairos kairos moment not kairos kairos kairos moment at the kairos moment the right time some of time sometimes you are using the chronos chronos chronos just the normal human time to measure

God's time don't use the chronos use the kairos kairos is God's time babies when they are ready to be born they don't care what time it is they don't care what day of the week or the month they don't care they operate with their timing not based on chronos childbirth always operates with kairos not chronos in the same way your testimony in God operates with kairos even though you are operating within chronos like now I have to be getting ready to end because we are operating within chronos some of us by the time we finish you have other things doing so I can't be going and going and going we are living in heaven's time no no heaven even respects human time so there's time for everything can you imagine if you have an exam tomorrow morning you're coming for fasting prayer and now this pastor is preaching and preaching for three hours because he believes that don't worry God will take care of you no you have to be worried if you are not learning preparing for the exam no there's no way a hands can be laid for you to do a pass exam and lay my hands receive it doesn't work like that anyone who has failed exam is because of what you wrote this is so much basic common sense it is abnormal to think otherwise that

Buddhist that Buddhist has not prayed or you know they pray but it's the only prayer in the name of Jesus that matters okay any other prayer Satan doesn't mind as long as you don't do it in the name of Jesus Satan can even pay you to do it why is it that Buddhist or that one who calls himself atheist why I say you have failed listen it's not because something was helping her because she prayed and she studied and you didn't pass because she potentially studied and understood more than you even though you prayed so pastor why should we be praying prayer is just your normal day because when you pray it helps you to bring your life in alignment with God's purpose for your time for your hour and to be in your testimony this week this week alone many people have contacted me pastor thank you my testimony

I'm hearing some life transforming testimony this fasting has changed a lot of things and your own is going to be part of it before the end of this year before the end of this year you receive your testimony you receive your ministry minus and so these someone receiving something.

We are receiving. Thank you, Jesus. Hebrews chapter 10, verse 35. Oh my God, I love you, Lord Jesus.

Cast not away therefore your confidence which has great recompense of reward. For ye have need of patience, but after ye have done the will of God. After. Someone say after. After. So finish the will of God before you expect.

You haven't worked and you are expecting salary. Wow. You got the job. They gave you the interview. They said, you've got a job. And they send you an email or a letter on the 27th of September that you've got the job.

[37:12] On the 30th of September you are expecting your salary. Please, why am I my salary not count? No. You haven't started working yet. You have to work. In the same way, you see, do it goes time and then you, the Bible said that if you do the will of God, after you have done the will of God, it says that for you have need of patience.

Wait, finish doing what God has told you. Finish doing it. Said after you have done the will of God, you might receive the promise. Verse 37. For yet a little while and he that shall come will come and will see the notary has appeared here again.

Some of the boyfriends, boyfriend, you can't take them anywhere. Wow. Wow. It's a message. It's a great message. Somebody's blessed. Amen.
