If you're here tonight With any kind of A sickness Or affliction That before the night Is over God wants to Heal you And make you Whole But Brother Donnie You don't know What I have Doesn't matter to God Don't tell me What you got You're liable To scare me To death Y'all ain't Listening to me I went to Kennett To To One woman got in the prayer line.

One woman walked up to that prayer line. I thought, well, nobody's sick but her. The church was going nuts. I went down and touched her. Holy Ghost anointing was all over me. My back was chilled from top to bottom.

My hand went numb. I laid my hand on her. I said, what's your name? She said, Sister Pat. I said, Sister Pat, God told me to tell you that you're healed of what's been bothering you. You're absolutely and totally healed.

Be healed in Jesus' name. The whole time she was pointing at her head like that. I saw a little nod up her. I just grabbed her. I thought she's got a headache. I said, Jesus, you said it. I believe it. Heal her. Down she went.

[ 29 : 15 ] The whole church went nuts. Turning, flips, rolling, screaming, worse than y'all are here tonight, if you believe that. After church, we're driving to the pastor's house.

He don't say a lot of words. You know Brother James Brown? He don't say much. He looked over and grinned. He said, Brother Don, do you really believe God spoke to you? I said, why, yeah. Kind of got offended.

I thought he was doubting me. He said, do you know what was wrong with Sister Pat? I said, no. He said, our church has been in turmoil over Sister Pat. She went to a doctor years and years ago, and they found a tumor in the middle of her brain the size of a marble.

Hear me. Hear me. He said, they said, when they go in to get it, there's more chance she'll die than there is she'll live. So they just left it alone. Now it's bigger than a golf ball.

And next week, she's going to St. Louis, and they're going to take it out. Seventy percent chance she won't make it. Y'all know what I thought?

[ 30 : 17 ] Do you want me to tell you? Y'all may want to run me back to Sacramento. I said, Brother James, I thought she had a headache. And I started doubting myself. But you see, God said he's going to heal.

So it didn't matter what Donnie Neal thought. I prayed for her for an excedrin headache, number 106. She had a tumor the size of a golf ball. And I doubted.

I got scared a little bit. And I said, Brother James, I thought she had a headache. He said, now what are you going to do? I said, Brother, I said it. I had to live with it. And I got home, got in my car, and drove back to Livermore, Kentucky, where I lived.

Four days later, I got a phone call, and this is how it was. I said, hello, and it's, ah! Ah! Ah! I thought, my God, somebody's getting killed. I said, who is this?

Calm down. Oh, Brother Donnie! Oh! I'll never forget it for as long as I live on planet Earth. I said, you have got to calm down and tell me who this is. She said, it's Sister Pat from Millersville.

[ 31 : 21 ] I said, my God, what's the matter? She said, I'm in St. Louis at the doctor's office. She called Brother James. She said, I got a little Japanese doctor. She said, I started this morning taking my first test.

She said, they've given me the same test four times. She said, I'm standing here. Y'all know. Y'all know what's coming. Y'all know. Y'all know what's coming. Y'all know. She said, after four tests, I said, stop it and tell me what's going on.

The doctor, little doctor or whatever, Chin or Lee, I don't know what his name was. Chin Lee. She said, he said, Miss Pat, I've been your doctor for 25 years.

She said, I know it. He said, and we don't make mistakes. He said, the reason you're waiting, I've done sent them across town to the other office and have them bring the x-rays. He said, because I've got to compare them to these.

He said, I have x-rays that show a tumor big as a golf ball. But these four sets we took just now, there ain't nothing there and I don't know what to say. And then she went back into.

[ 32 : 39 ] See, when God said you're going to do it, it don't matter what. So I learned. I tell them, don't tell me what's wrong with you. I don't want to know you. I was scared. But I didn't come with this in mind.

I have good little, I'm going to preach tonight on one word in the Bible, if. I'm going to preach tonight on if, two-letter word. Just lay out. But we're sitting there singing that last song I sang right then.

Believe I'll be here when Jesus comes. And I believe most every person in this building tonight is going to be here when Jesus splits the sky. I believe it. I believe it.

But while I was sitting there thinking about that, Jesus came along and said, I'm going to heal somebody tonight. So if you have a sickness or affliction, I'm telling you, get your faith rolling. I preached two weeks ago in my church about that scripture that we preach forever.

If you have faith, that's a grain of a mustard seed. I've never seen one. Everybody in my church has brought me mustard seeds. I'm down there with a bunch of hillbillies. And I never knew they were so little.

[ 33 : 41 ] And I've been looking to them and gave me little oil bottles in there. One little mustard seed floats around in there. And I've been looking at going, oh, God, help my faith. If it only takes that much to move a mountain, I need to do some praying.

I thought I at least had faith the size of a softball or something. But anyway, God's going to heal you tonight. Do you want to be healed? I'm asking anybody here tonight that's got an affliction, sickness, cancer, don't matter to God.

Who knows big words about God saying, Holy Ghost sinner, I'd shut up and just preach if. But if you've got sickness on you tonight, if you've got an affliction, if you've got a disease, start believing right now, you're going to be healed. And we're going to pray for you just shortly.

Somebody say, I believe. That's good, Brother Vanley. Say, I believe it. I believe it. I believe it. Well, well, well, the devil don't like what's going on around here.

The devil don't like what's going on around here. But we don't care what the devil don't like. We're going to be here anyhow. The devil don't like what's going on around here.

[ 34 : 53 ] Well, the devil don't want us clapping hands around here. The devil don't want y'all clapping hands around here. But we don't care what the devil don't like.

We're going to clap hands anyhow. The devil don't want you clapping hands around here. Well, the devil don't like that bass guitar here. Devil don't like no bass guitar here.

But we don't care what the devil don't like, brother Darryl's gonna pick it. Anyhow, the devil don't like no bass. Let's pick on the devil's head. Pick it, brother! Oh, the devil don't like it, I can tell.

Well, the devil don't like brother KJ's pickin' round here. Devil don't like brother KJ's pickin' round here. Well, we don't care what the devil don't like, brother KJ's pickin'.

Anyhow, the devil don't like... I'm tellin', the devil's shiverin' right now. Get on him, KJ! Oh, the devil don't like no drum play round here.

[ 36 : 17 ] Devil really hates that drum pick round here. But we don't care what the devil don't like, brother Boomer gonna play it. Anyhow, the devil don't... Y'all watch the devil get real mad right here.

Let him have it, boy! I wanna hear that one more time.

The devil's runnin' now! Well, the devil don't like no left-handers round here.

The devil don't like no Southpaws round here. But we don't care what the devil don't like. I'm still left-handed anyhow. The devil don't like no left-hand pickin' round here.

Well, the devil don't like no shoutin' round here. The devil don't want a shoutin' round here.

[ 37 : 29 ] The devil don't want a shoutin' round here. But we don't care what the devil don't like. We wanna shout anyhow. Yeah, yeah, yeah, yeah, yeah. Yeah!

Let the devil have it! Let him have it! Yeah! Yeah! Yeah! Yeah! Yeah! Let's go up higher! Go up higher! Lift the name up higher! Lift it up higher!

God is so good. He's so good to me.

God is so good. Glory. Somebody shout glory.

Come on, let me hear you shout glory. Come on, shout glory. Woo! Woo! Woo! This kind of a phrase I was just doing.

[ 47 : 57 ] Just for a minute. Brother, this mic's anointed. Don't let it hurt you. Oh, yeah, yeah. You know, we don't have to waste a lot of time. We don't have to prep us a lot of things. Hallelujah. I know y'all believe in healing this church.

Hold on before we start the music. I don't have to tell these stories to build anybody's faith. But you know, when you hear stories, it builds your faith.

First of all, I'm not even going to look, but is there anybody that's sick tonight that wants to be healed? Say amen. Oh, my. All right. Everybody's sick. That's good. I'll be preaching on a minute where the Bible says that Jesus will come and heal our land.

And that don't mean your acre 1.2 that you own out of town. But this is your land. But I want y'all to hear me just for a minute. I want you all, you undivided to just for a minute.

I want to share something with you that's been happening. Not 10 years ago. I like stuff like this. I grew up hearing preachers telling stories. And I used to say, Oh, I wish I was back there in the good old days.

[ 48 : 58 ] Well, God's a God today, too. I started a church 21 months ago. And everything I'm about to tell you has happened in the last 21 months. I'm not going to tell you at all. But right before I pray for you, I feel like doing this to help increase your faith.

I just told you about this lady where I laid hands on her and the tumor went away. But that was about five, six years ago. Let me tell you something. A lady in Massville, Kentucky named Deborah Walker. She's a waitress over at the Cracker Barrel in Madisonville.

You can go there and see her today and ask her if this story's true, Brother Van. Her mother come to the church. I knew her. I pastored her before. She said, Brother Donnie, Debbie weighs 97 pounds. A 36-year-old woman weighed 97 pounds.

She looked like bones with skin. She's eat up with cancer in her female parts. Her surgery is in the morning. She didn't even know I'd had a church. Sister Sue, her mama, heard I had a church and came to find us and said, Brother Donnie, she goes in in the morning.

I grabbed a bunch of our church people. We'd been having the spirit move. We'd been fighting every devil out of hell. And some I didn't know was in there, but we'd still been having surgery. We went to the hospital at 9.30 at night, Madisonville Hospital.

[ 50 : 00 ] We walked in and I looked at her, and folks, she looked just like death. This young, beautiful young lady that used to be my personal church secretary over in Madisonville, Kentucky, when I pastored there, she was a very healthy, vim and vigor-filled young lady, looked like a skeleton.

I walked in and she said, listen to me now, listen to me. She said, Brother Donnie. That's all she could say. Brother Donnie. Now, I'm nobody, first of all. I'm not claiming I carry any healing around with me.

I didn't go out and buy me a tent and an 18-wheel truck and put Don Neal healing ministry. What if God don't want to heal anymore for a while with me? What if he used somebody else? I bought a truck for nothing. Big-time evangelist, I like them, but listen, they're going to town and saying Wednesday night's healing night.

What if God wants to heal on Tuesday? So I know all that stuff, and I don't pull rabbits out of hats, but I got enough sense to know when God says do it, just do it. I'm like old Brother Leonard Connors used to say.

Somebody said, what if you pray for somebody that don't get healed? He said, I don't take the credit when they get healed, so I ain't going to take the blame when they don't. Amen. Yeah. We went in that hospital room. I said, Sister Debbie, you're at death's door.

[ 51 : 04 ] She said, I know it. I said, we're going to pray and believe. Do you believe God can heal you? Brother Van laying there looking like a scum. I'm telling you, her eyes were sunk all the way back. Imagine 36-year-old girl with 97 pounds, and I said, Debbie, do you believe God can heal you?

She said, I believe. We laid hands on her, began to pray. We began to stomp and shake the floor and rebuke. Four or five of my people broke out in Holy Ghost tongues. Amen. A heavenly language fell down, tongues of fire, and we prayed.

And I saw the nurses come in the door, and her mama Sue said, get out, get out, get out. That nurse said, we're the nurse. Sue said, we're paying for the room. Get out, get out. We prayed and got hold of God, the healer.

Said, oh God, by your stripes she is healed. We began to pray an awful God prayer that came on us, a God awful Holy Ghost filled prayer. Amen. Amen. And she, tears run down her eyes, and them little old bony skeleton arms raised in there.

Y'all ain't going to believe me, but I'll preach anyway. I wouldn't dare stand here and tell you a lie like it's the truth. We went home. I said, what time's her surgery? Sister Sue said, nine o'clock in the morning. I said, oh my.



[ 52 : 08 ] We'll be in service, but we'll be praying for you. We'll be over here as soon as service is over. We went to service that morning and prayed for her. Had a Holy Ghost conviction fit in church. Amen. After church, I headed to the hospital.

I walked in the door and Sue was standing in the waiting room going, hallelujah, hallelujah, hallelujah. I said, Sue, what? What's happening? I know God says something.

She said, brother Donnie, I want you to come meet the doctor. The doctor had come out, went in to do surgery. Used to be Sue's doctor. Now he's doctoring on her 36-year-old daughter. He'd been doctoring a long time.

He came out. He went in and said, Sue, now it's going to be a long operation. It's going to be tedious. It's going to be bad. She said he walked in there, was in there about 45 minutes. He walked out and stood at the door and went. And Sue said, doctor, oh God, what's the matter?

Her faith slipped for a minute. He said, Sue, I'll tell you in a minute. He went back in the door. He come back out a few minutes and sat down. And his first words were, Sue, I've been your doctor for a long time. He said, we've cut into Debbie and her private female parts.

[ 53 : 06 ] We can't find any cancer. She's healed.

She's healed. She's healed. She's healed. Go to Madisonville, Kentucky to the Cracker Barrel. Go in and ask for Debbie Walker. And you'll see about a 120-pound young lady, vibrant and beautiful.

And she'll say, yes, God healed me completely of cancer. Not 10 years ago. Not five years ago. But about a year and a half ago.

He's a now God. Come on. Right now. Right now. I got a man that's a member of my church today. And he said, Brother Don, wish y'all could hear him talk.

I could sit and listen to him for an hour and just talk. He said, big old, big old burly man, one of the toughest men I ever met in my life. Brother Jay Stanley, 77 years old.

[ 54 : 11 ] I never seen anybody with so much power. He's got a hand. It's unbelievable. He was in the mines one time, KJ working in the mines. And they was working on something and something blowed up. And the blast shot him 60 feet down that tunnel and through a wall.

There was some kind of a wall. They called it a thin wall. And on the other side was another time. Shot him through the wall. And the smoke cleared. Two or three men were in severe condition. They came down and got him out. But nobody could find Jay.

He said he could hear him talking in the background. But all was dark blackness. And somebody said, Jay Stanley got blown through that wall. Somebody else said, he's dead. Let's don't go get him. The man said, no, I don't want to see the sight that there is.

Jay said he went to say, I'm here. Help me. And he couldn't speak. He was laying there in the darkness. Finally, one guy later on, almost an hour later, said, well, let's go down there and find the pieces. And this is what he heard them saying. And as they came through their lights, there he laid.

It blowed all of his clothes off. It blowed his coveralls. It blowed all of his clothing off. He was laying there in his underwear. But he was laying there. And they said, Jay, are you okay? He said, help me get up. And they stood him up and he walked out of there.

[ 55 : 13 ] Now, wait a minute. That's not what I meant to tell you. That happened years ago. I'm going to tell you about the now God. Brother Jay Stanley said, Brother Don, I'm with you all the way. For God is a good God.

And for God thinks God's children ought to be following the Bible. And that's the way he talks. I ain't putting on a bit. Oh, I could hear him for an hour, hon. How you doing? Good to see you. Bless you. I love you. I think about you all the time. He said, Brother Don, for I believe that if we follow God, God's power will follow us.

That's how you do. Oh, I love it. I call him sometimes. I say, Brother Jay, let's just talk a little while. But when I first met him, one year ago, I went to hold a revival in White Plains, Kentucky, at Little Mission Church. I walked into church.

And I said, God's going to heal tonight. It was one of them other healing nights. And this man come up, and he looked like a hunchback. He had a knot. And I'm trying to get him to come up here tomorrow night. And I'll let you meet this gentleman.

If not, I will get him up here in the future. All my folks were mad at me because of such a short notice. They all couldn't come tonight. But anyway, he looked like a hunchback. He had a knot that went from his ear down to his neck. It was that big, and it was hard.

[ 56 : 12 ] You hit it. It was like that table. He come up and said, Brother Don, I want prayer. Didn't know who he was from a man in the moon. I said, Brother, do you believe God can heal you? He said, yes, sir. Big old ugly. He said, Brother Don, feel of it.

I thought, I want to feel of it. But he made me put my hands on it. It felt like one of them ends of them pews. I don't know what his problem was. It was ungodly. And I said, everybody, stretch your hands forth.

And I called up four or five of the preachers. And I said, Father God, in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, we begin to pray. I don't know what the prayer was. We begin to pray, and down he went into the floor.

Went on home. The next night of the revival, the next night, I was standing on the platform. I can't see. I can't see like I used to. I've got glasses over there now. I can't see like I used to. But I seen somebody come in the door, and they was doing this.

And he walked up the aisle, and he was grabbing people's hands, and he was going. And he would come down and grab his gun. I thought, what in God's name is he? And I seen his brother Jay. And he walked on the front and said, Brother Don, when he gets your hand, you bend God.

[ 57 : 09 ] He said, put your hand there. And his neck was normal, just like mine, just like yours. It was gone. Don't somebody believe me. It was gone. I don't have nothing to do with any of that.

I just happened to be there when it happened. I'm telling you, the same God is here tonight, the same Holy Ghost anointing. God wants to heal you. He don't have nothing against one person in his church.

God does not hate or abhor anybody that's in this building tonight. God loves you. He wants you to be healed. And I believe he's going to do it right now.

If you have a sickness, if you have anything, you come and get up here real quick and believe God. Get in this line real quickly while the anointing's here. If you're at your seat and you feel healthy and you don't come up, wonderful, I'm so glad.

But please stretch your hand this way because I need your faith to help me with mine. And let's believe God to heal. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, that's it, brother.

[ 58 : 27 ] Be healed in the name of Jesus. Come on, honey, it's here. It's powerful. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, by the Holy Ghost anointing of God, be healed. Whatever your condition is, doesn't matter to God.

You're healed in the name of Jesus. I tell you, it's so powerful. Come on, my brother. Oh, yeah, blah, blah, blah, blah, blah, blah, blah, blah, blah. Somebody say, I believe. I believe.

Father, whatever his problem is, doesn't matter to you. Heal him right now. Right now, there it is. I rebuke you sickness. Oh, oh, oh, oh. Get out in the name of Jesus.

Woo, saints, I feel it. I feel it. Come stand right here, my brother. Brother Van needs some help. Yeah. Watch this. Father, watch this.

Boy, brother. Hold on, hold on. I ain't been here in a long time. I ain't been here in a long time.

[ 59 : 31 ] I see so many people I don't know. I see a lot of people I just don't even know. Well, I know the Holy Ghost is a gentleman. Holy Ghost is a gentleman.

He never do nothing to embarrass you. If you ever been in a church and somebody did something to embarrass somebody, that wasn't the Holy Ghost. That was flesh. Brother, I'm going to pray for you. God's going to heal you what you're here for.

But first, God said, hear this. Hear this. Hear this. I know we're praising, but try to listen all you can.

Down inside of you, there is a real desire to go on for God. More than a lot of people see. There's a really, there's a, I see a fire way down under the branches, way down in there.

But there's a big old hand that's been stopping you for a big, now I'm going to tell you, I'm not going for God. You're a big old man. But there's been a big old hand stopping you.

[ 60 : 30 ] Something. Something. You take off a running and it just comes up. You take off, say, I'm going to really try this time, it just comes up. I don't even feel like it's a devil. It's somebody, somewhere, something that just keeps coming up.

I got ready to lay hands on you just now. And I saw that hand come up and I saw a bigger hand come and smack it away. You're going to go, brother. You're going to make it. You're going to be on fire.

And you're going to be healed. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth. Healing from head to toe. Somebody praise God with you. People can be so cruel.

People can be so cruel and so mean. Hallelujah. Hallelujah. Watch out. That brother is going to go and get on fire and turn loose. My God.

Everything he's been wanting to do, he's going to turn loose and do. Y'all doing good. I don't mean y'all ain't telling y'all stuff.

[ 61 : 47 ] But I just want you to hold up for a second while I'm still here. One time I was here before and God moved like this. And I called a young drummer boy. I looked at a young drummer boy that was here at night. And I said, brother Boomer, the devil wants you.

I said, the world will be after you. If you don't watch out, you go. Oh. It happened, didn't it, brother? I'm not embarrassing you. I'm just trying to say. When God's.

You remember E.F. Hutton? You said, when God speaks, you better listen. There was a pretty young girl here at night. Where's she at? I seen her earlier. A young lady that was here at night. I believe that was her I saw just a minute ago.

I called you out that night. God prophesied to you that night. I don't know if you remember that, but I do. And I heard God did. Moved on you.

Well, let that brother loose. Let him have his way. God's going to turn him loose. But I just felt like saying it's a shame when people try to hold you back. And when people get in your way. Oh, it's awful. It's awful. Now God's still here.

[ 62 : 42 ] Y'all play again. And God's going to hear. Don't tell me what's wrong with you when you come up. Don't tell me. It doesn't matter. I couldn't do nothing about it anyway. But God wants to. Yeah, let's go straight to that sister. Oh, somebody put the top back on oil. Keep it open because somebody.



Listen to this. We all know, but your hair is your glory. And God said, don't you fight that about your hair. You let that hair alone. You let it go. Because there's going to be such glory on you. Hey! When you shout and that old hair goes, it knocks devils out.

It knocks demons out. It knocks spirits out. Don't be let down, hon. God loves you. He's going to anoint you. Father, touch her and heal her. In the name of Jesus, I'm actually a healer.

And give her the anointing of power on his hair. Glory, I have said, in the name of Jesus. Somebody shout with her. Somebody shout with her. Where'd she go?

Oh, that's her. She already looks different. There's a praying, healing spirit on me. There's a preaching spirit on me. Ain't that precious?

[ 68 : 47 ] I mean, all of our hair speaks of glory, but there's going to be glory on that. When that lady gets that hair, that little young girl starts doing like this, devil's going to jump out the walls. Demon's going to take off running.

Evil spirits are going to flee. Y'all look at me like you believe it. Brother Van wants nobody to work on his hair.

I want to say this. I want to say this. This is free. Don't cost you nothing. We ain't took up an offer and everything's free so far. No. This is free. It's just a saying. I got this. This is free. We're nothing but a bunch of voices.

Let me just throw this in here. I don't know what. We're all voices. Y'all hear me? Remember just me and I said everything's alive? The world has a voice. Here I go again. Rocks have a voice, boomer.

Trees have a voice. Read the Bible. It says the trees swaying their arms, appraising God. The birds have a voice. Everything is alive and everything has a voice. But nothing on earth has more voices than human beings.

[ 69 : 51 ] You got four voices. Can I share this with you just for a second? I just feel like I can't preach this all the time everywhere. But I feel like I can here. I want to just share this with you. Don't ever forget this. You got four voices, Connie.

The voice of your mouth. The voice of your mouth. Want me to prove you got one? Everybody go, hey! That's one voice.

That's your weakest of all your voices. Number two, your blood has a voice. I know you know that. Your blood has a voice. Cain killed Abel.

God came along and said, Cain, where's your brother? Cain said, am I my brother's keeper? Started smarting off to God. That don't shock me. I've had church people smart off to God.

God say, humble yourself. He said, I ain't going to do it. God said, go over and pray for that person during service. He said, no, I'll let somebody. Brother Dan's a pastor. Let him do it. We all smart off to God.

[ 70 : 47 ] Cain said, am I my brother's keeper? And God said these words. Remember them. The voice of thy brother's blood cries out to me from the ground.

Ladies and gentlemen, your blood has a voice. But that's not the important part. When you got saved, you got saved and washed in what? The blood of Jesus Christ.

My God, now think of what a voice. The Bible said that at the great white throne judgment, the blood of Jesus will speak better things than that of Abel. There's your second voice.

Your third voice. David said, I cried unto the Lord and he heard the voice of my tears. Now your mouth has a voice.

Your blood has a voice. Plead the blood over you every day. You get a bigger voice to rebuke the devil. When the devil comes up, it's not just you saying, devil, leave me alone. But a voice that you're covered in says, get out of here.

[ 71 : 53 ] And when you cry to the Lord and let those tears flow down that face like that young lady was doing this a minute ago, that's a voice. Matter of fact, I think the Bible said somewhere, I don't think I'm mistaken, that God takes and scoops them up in a tear bottle and keeps them.

And last but not least, this is what got me on this, that young lady I prayed for. Your last voice you have is your hair. Your hair has a voice. Oh God, I'm stepping in all kinds of ground here.

Everybody goes, the old time of Pentecostal, people go, the man is the ruler of the house and he's the boss. And when he says jump, the woman says how high.

I want to tell you something. If your hair is a voice and God said for a man to have short hair, for a woman to have long hair, and I'm not preaching on that tonight, but I'm just getting on this. Then you tell me who has more power.

The woman. I'm sorry, please give him the offering. But the woman. I found out the woman is the protector.

[ 72 : 59 ] The man is the provider. That's why more women get in the spirit than men do. That's why women shout more than men do. Now, I don't mean to leave you out, men.

We're shouting too. But I can't do nothing about when you see these ladies with that hair start doing that, me and you just can't get her done. I hope there's a glory in us shouting our foreheads. But there's a glory right here in this.

There's a glory right there in that. There's a glory right there in that. There's a glory right there. Are y'all with me? Hallelujah. Hallelujah. So we're just a bunch of voices.

Aye, aye, aye, aye, aye, aye, aye, aye, aye. So where that young lady goes, hear her. Hold on to that, hon. Hold on to that. Woo.

I know you're powerful. There's nothing wrong with you. You ain't as bad as sometimes the devil makes you think you are. You ain't. He'll torment you. Hallelujah, hon. Boy, you won't need healing, don't you? I know you do.

[ 74 : 01 ] Oh, boy, God wants to heal you. Oh, in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth. Father, reach down with your mighty hand and touch my sister. Oh, I feel right there.

Be healed. Receive your healing. Receive that healing. In the name of Jesus. Oh, I love the way God does things. Is there anybody else before it lifts?

Is there anybody else? What do we have? Woo. Come on, guys. Touch this baby.

It's not impossible. It's not impossible. It's not impossible with God. Would you all clap for him one more time? It's not impossible.

It's not impossible. You're here for prayer for him. I don't know if this has to do with you or not, but Brother Van's wife's name is Pat.

[ 75 : 22 ] But the Lord just come to me and said, Patty. Patty. Patty. Patty. Patty. I said, Patty. Somewhere. That's all right.

Oh, my God. Yes, Lord. Amen. Seven straight. Dear Jesus. I know that takes a toll. Well, I say it's working.

How about you? Yeah. I got ready to pray for you. The Lord said, Patty. Hmm.

A door is going to open. A door is going to open. Are you married? Are you a husband? The door is going to open for you all. I'm going to get up.

I see none of my books. I'm going to get up. Some kind of, and I say work. I don't know if it's natural work or spiritual work.

[ 76 : 27 ] That God is, you're not leaving. I see a spiritual something you've been looking for. It's a work. A work. Why am I? I've got to say what God's telling me to say. I see a spiritual work you've been desiring. And God's going to open the door.

And to prove to you that he's God, it's going to associate with the name Patty. Remember that. Don't forget. Don't forget this. Don't forget this. And when it happens, if it happens, when it happens, when it happens, come and testify right here in this church.

And tell them, now keep your eyes open for it. Look for it. If God opens any dealings for you spiritually, any kind of something you've been looking, I don't have no idea. It don't go no farther than that. You ask people's names. I don't see Pat.

I don't see Patricia. I see Patty. Something about that. Something's going to be involved with that somewhere, somehow. I just believe that. Husband, it's going to happen to you, too. It's going to happen for you, too. It's going to happen for you, too. Woo!

Y'all have such a need. Y'all have such a need. I've got to pray for your healing, but y'all have such a need. Ha ha. Oh, you're going to be healed, sister.

[ 77 : 33 ] You're about to be healed. I know it, y'all. I know it again. I know it three times. I know it four times. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, by the power of the Holy Ghost, by authority of the Word of God, I claim healing for this, sister.

You foul, evil, sickness, whatever you are, I rebuke you. I command you under the authority of the Holy Ghost to loosen your hold and come out and leap.

Sister, receive that healing right now. Pour it out upon your head. All over your body. Be healed in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth. Ooh, be healed. I feel it, honey. You feel that? Be healed in the name of Jesus.

Be completely healed. Don't hold on to that no longer. Anybody else? Oh, I don't feel it leaving, but I do feel it lifting. Oh, this is sister Neacham.

Oh, yeah, that's good. Yeah. Oh, the whole floor and everything. There you go. Ha, ha, bless your heart. Oh, Jesus loves you. Jesus loves you. That's not a real big prophecy.

[ 78 : 40 ] Everybody knows Jesus loves you. Jesus told me to tell you he really loves you. He don't have to heal you to prove he loves you, but he's going to heal you.

He's going to heal you, hon. Watch this. He's going to heal you. Don't ever forget Jesus loves you. Jesus loves you. Jesus healed your daughter. Heal your daughter right there.

Hold on a bucket of there. I feel it. Loosen. Loosen yourself. Loosen. Loosen and come out. Loosen and be gone. I deny your authority. Be healed in the name of Jesus.

Be healed completely and made whole. Oh, somebody give him one more good hand clap of praise. Is that it?

I'm done. I'm ready to go. Oh, here's another. Hallelujah. Okay. Ain't that something?

[ 79 : 46 ] Okay. Oh, my Lord. I believe that. Woo.

She's got power. She's got power. Woo. Hallelujah. Hallelujah. Hey, I, Brother Van Meeze is excited.

He was talking to me, but I wish he'd have waited just a minute. Let me tell you what. You know you got a calling. The Bible said many are called, but few were chosen.

So calling is one step, and chosen is another step. And then it says faithful. See, a lot of people called, but they don't go on and get chosen. And there's a lot of people get chosen, but they don't stay faithful.

God said you be called, chosen, and faithful. Faithful. See, called, you ain't got nothing to do with it. He calls you. And you don't have a lot to do with being chosen. You can make a choice for him that he makes one.

[ 80 : 45 ] But being faithful is all you. It all falls on you. Let me tell you what I just saw. When you come up here, and then Brother Van got excited and told me. In the Bible, I wasn't reading it two weeks ago. Children of Israel was in a battle.

Moses held his hands up, and they went. But he getting tired, his hands go down, and they start losing, backing up. He stuck them hands back up, and they went.

His hands go get tired, and finally two of the men that was close to him, two of the people of God. I'm going to say men, not a chauvinist. Two of the people of God. Yeah, come over, and got his arms and held them up.

And the children of Israel won until they wiped out everything. You know what God just showed me? You've been sitting here to hold up them hands. Whoa, God, oh my. I don't even know if she goes to church here, but you said one of your ministers. Okay, she does.

Hold up them hands, and the same blessing that falls on the pastor will fall on you. Hold up. Bye-bye-bye. And you've got to be healed to do it.

[ 81 : 42 ] Be healed in the name of Jesus. Be healed from your head to your feet. Be healed. Be healed. Ah! Of all these things, be healed. Be completely healed.

Somebody shout hallelujah. Woo! Woo! Ah! Turn around this way, brother.

Just turn around here. I just feel like getting this way. Hallelujah. Hallelujah. Give me a little bit old here. Hallelujah. Yeah.

Ha, ha, ha, ha. Lord. Lord. Touch my brother. Touch my brother. Hey, you devil, you're a liar.

God made this body. Ooh. Ho, ho, ho. God made this body as it pleased him. The Bible said we are fearfully and wonderfully made. We're so important that God counts every hair on our head.

[ 82 : 46 ] And in the name of Jesus, be healed right now. I feel healing coursing through these veins. I feel healing. God. I said healing.

Now, be mended. Be mended. Be mended. Be mended. Be mended. Be mended. Be, be. I feel that.

I feel, I feel. Be loosed and be freed. Be open in the name of Jesus Christ. The Lord speaks it.

The Lord speaks it. God bless that brother's heart. Hallelujah. Hallelujah. Isn't that sweet?

Isn't that wonderful? My baby. Jesus. Heal her. Heal her completely of everything that's bothering her.

[ 83 : 47 ] Heal her. Heal, heal, heal, heal, heal, heal, heal, heal, heal, heal, heal, heal. Heal her.

Heal her. Ha, ha, ha, ha. What a broken heart. What a broken, contrite heart. Hey, hey, hey.

Isn't that precious? Let's lift up our hands and love God. Just love Him. Thank you, Jesus. We love you, Jesus. We're so unworthy of all these blessings.

We're unworthy of all these things. Thank you, Jesus. Oh. Oh, Jesus. Oh, God's going to heal you, Jesus.

And listen to this. Listen to this. They're coming. They're coming. They're coming. Oh, your heart's been heavy. Oh, your heart's been heavy.

[ 85 : 01 ] Oh, listen to this. God told me to tell you. They're going to come in before it's too late. Isn't that amazing? They're going to come in before it's too late.


