[5:12] I'm not going to be... Come on, somebody. Come on. One of these days... Thank you, Lord. I'm not going to be around. Come on, man. But, Teresa, can I be truthful with you all?

Yeah. Come on. Come on. You know, I'm still grieving. Amen. I'm grieving. And, you know, I still grieve so hard. Yeah. And I owe you all an apology.

I do. I owe you an open apology because... There's times where I just didn't want to talk to nobody.

Because we watched them. We watched everybody. But he'd get up. And I'm murdered.

Yeah. Come on. He'd get up and get a shower. After he'd get out of the shower, he'd go to the coffee pot. Matter of fact, he'd turn the coffee pot on before he'd go get in the shower so he'd have a cup of coffee.

He'd get out of the shower, dry off, go get the coffee. I know I'm probably weeding some of y'all out of here. Come on, Dad. Come on. I'm just being truthful. I'm not. I'm not. I'm not. He knew exactly how much to put in there to fill that cup up.

Right now in the name of Jesus. No weapon fought against this church shall prosper. Devil, get your hands off of this congregation.

Get your hands off of every lips. Come on, somebody. I need some prayer warriors. I need somebody to buy the chains of darkness. Don't cut it off, church.

This doesn't come by this way very often. find you a prayer partner tonight.

Find you somebody. See God. enough is enough.

[27:09] I'm messing with spirits that bind us and so easily beset us. God. You have heard me tell this story before.

And I believe it with all my heart. I'm going to say it again because there's probably people here that's never heard it. There was a gentleman by the name of Lester Summerall,! Well-known minister.

Matter of fact, he was Rob Parsley's minister. That's who he came up under. Lester Summerall went overseas on a mission. They put him up in a shack in the low shack.

No air conditioner, bro-chef, no nothing. First night, 1200 gave their heart to God. The second night was around 1500.

It was grown. After Brother Lester Summerall came back to his shack the second night, he went in and he laid in the bed. And all of a sudden, he felt his being started shaking.

If he's not, you're not being a good enough Christian. You're not praying hard enough. He's not scared of you. Amen. When he begins to bother you, when he begins to bother you, when he begins to wake you up in the midnight hour, you are considered a threat.

You are a threat. Look at Shimea and say you're a threat to the devil. Brother Lester Summerall comes back to the shack.

No air conditioners. windows and has some curtains. He pops open the windows. Takes the curtains and hangs them up because the wind is blowing in.

It's so hot he needs some air. He's awakened by his bed. Rattling. true story.

[29:35] True story. He wakes up Rattling. Rattling. His bed has been shifted to the middle of the room.

He looks over to the walls and the curtains. The wind began to roar. And it began to blow them curtains. And he got up out of that bed.

And he said, Oh my God. Oh my God. Devil, I bind you in the name of Jesus. In the name of Jesus, every knee shall bow.

And I call upon the name of the Lord and rebuke you to get off of this ministry. And then all of a sudden, the wind quit blowing, the drapes shut back down, and the bed quit shaking.
