So that accountability to one another, that pushing each other to obey God's word so that we might have community, and also the welcome of those who we don't know and who are new Christians into the family of God are crucial to us and to our life as a family of God. It is in fact what Jesus was talking about when he said, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did it unto me. Amen.
