That Jesus Would have said And sung these Psalms And not only that But he actually Lived them out In very specific ways And we can say These Psalms In Christ As believers of his These become Our Psalms As we say Them either true For Christ In us Or true In our own Personal experience So I pray That this Psalm Will be one That you say Heartily As you remember David As you remember Jesus And as you Join with Jesus In saying This Psalm So David So David writes The Psalm To fellow pilgrims On a journey Of faith He writes This Psalm For the Israelites He writes This Psalm For you And for me Under the inspiration Of the Spirit It would have been Sung probably And we've done Lots of singing This morning And we will continue To sing After this Sermon And we join As we read This Psalm With that longing To remember What God has done

Delivered Me The Lord Delivered Me Instead He Repeatedly Marvels At What God Has Done I Wonder If You Looking Back On Your Own Life And You See Things That You've Gone Through Times You've Been Through And You Wonder How On Earth You're Still Standing I Remember Have You Had Those Kind Of Situations In A Car Where You're Driving Along And Then Something Happens And You Go They Should Have Hit Me Anybody Had This Or Is Just Me And You Kind Of Go Did I Have Half A Car During That Last Maybe I'm Just Strange Maybe My Eyesight Is Not Very Good You're All Looking At Me Like He's I Don't Know That May Be A Minor Thing You Say Just Drive Better Malcolm I'm Sure That Would Be True My Wife Would Agree With You Actually On That But There We Go And Then Paul Says And Perhaps Sums Up What I Think David Had Discovered He Says What Then Shall We Say In Response To All This Stuff That Has Been Happening In Our Lives If God Is For Us Can You Help Me Who Can Be Against Us That's What He's Discovered He Can Have The Whole Of The Of Saul's Powerful King You Know Organization An Army Against Him And Yet David Still Survives He Can Have A Lion And A Bear Against Him And Yet He Survives Of Course The Greatest Deliverance That I'm Sure David Would Be Thinking Of As He Wrote This Part The Old Testament The Exodus And In The Exodus The People Of Israel Were Enslaved In Egypt And Pharaoh Was A Very Oppressive Pharaoh In Egypt And He Was Getting Everything Out Of The People Of Israel They Were Having An Awful Time And The Book Of Exodus Catalogues The Numerous Ways In Which The People Of God Are Delivered You Remember Eventually After Many Plagues Trying To Force Pharaoh To Let The People Go And Worship God Eventually The Final Plague Comes And The First Born In Every Household Dies And Suddenly It Gets To The Heart Of Pharaoh And He Says Okay Just Go Just Go Just Leave This Place And So All The People Of Israel Leave And They Are Set Free To Worship God But Before Long Of Course The Armies Of Egypt Are Bearing Down On Them As They Come To The Red Sea And They Feel Like They're Like A Bird Caught There Between The Army And The Sea It's Like They're Trapped And You'll See Some Of That Narrative In The Psalm Which We'll Come To In A Moment And Then God Opens A Path Through That Sea And Saves Those People A Bit Like The Door Of The Cage Has Been Opened And They Set Free And The Remarkable Thing Is They Thought They Were Trapped They Thought They Were Going To Die In The In The Waters And Eventually They're Set Free And The Armies Of Egypt Drown In The Red Sea As It Comes Back Over Where The Dry Land Has Been Unsurprisingly David At The End Of This Cataloguing Of Wonderful Deliverance Says Praise The Lord Praise The Lord I Mean Anything Less Than A Full Blood Praise The Lord Would Be Ridiculous Wouldn't It And That's What He's Doing In This Psalm Let Me Read To You Again Verses 1 To 5 So If The Lord Had Not Been On Our Side Let Israel Say Verse 2 If The Lord Had Not Been On Our Side When People Attack Us And Of Course He Was Verse Keep Going It's Like So Bad I Can't Even See The Three They Would Have Swallowed Us Up Alive When Their Anger Flared Against Us The Flood Would Have Engulfed Us The Torrent Would Have Swept Over Us The Raging Waters Would Have Swept Us Away That Is The Context That David Offers Praise And Worship How Wonderful So The Second Part Of The Psalm This Marvelling At The Deliverance Of God Looks At Then Praising God Let's Have A Look At Verses Six To Eight And Again We'll Read Those Sorry Keeping You Working Hard Aren't I Andrew Praise Be To The Lord Who Has Not Let Us Be Torn By Their Teeth Which Teeth [57:32] Might Be Thinking About The Bear The Lion Maybe Saul I Don't Know We Have Escaped The Bird From The Fowler's Snare The Snare Has Been Broken And We Have Escaped What Might You Be Thinking About I Kind Of Gave That One Away Perhaps You Feel It Would Be Not Cool To The Red Sea Thinking Back To What Has Happened To The People Of Israel Our Help Is In The Name Of The Lord The Maker Of Heaven And Earth What Might He Be Thinking Of When He Said Those Words Against I Come At You In The Name Of The Lord With Goliath Do You Get The Kind Of Idea I Think He's Got Things On His Mind When He Is Praising The Lord I Hope We've Got Things On Our Mind When We Praise The Lord Too C.S.

Lewis Says This About Speaking About The Psalms And The Value He Placed On The Psalms He Said The Psalms Have Helped Him To Express Delight In God That Even Prompted David To Dance Wow Wouldn't It Be Amazing If After This Morning Service You Go Home And You Go

Psalm 124 I'm Going To Dance Before The Lord For His Deliverance Wouldn't That Be Great To Do That Whereas What Often We Do We Kind Of Do You Know I Mean It Would Be Better For Us Wouldn't It Do You Think I Don't Know Get The Idea Few Of You Are Going To Do This If You Send Videos In That Would Be Amazing So If You Can't Find Your Own Voice To Praise The Lord The Psalms Offer You A Voice They Offer You The Voice Of David They Offer You The Voice Of Jesus And As You Enter Into That By The Spirit You Start To Discover That They Are On Your Lips These Psalms Are Your Psalms As You Are The New People Of God Who Are Discovering All The Ways In Which God Has Saved You And Preserved You Under All Sort Of Circumstances Let Me Just Remind You Of A Few That God Has Done As New Testament Believers Think About What God Has Done For You For A Moment In Jesus I'll Remind You Once We Were Enslaved To Sin And Then Jesus Came Dying On A Cross Once We Were Entrapped Like A Bird Compelled To Sin Sometimes We See People And They Seem That's All They Seem To Do

Is Sin I Was Hearing A Story This Morning Talking To Somebody On A Dog Walk I Wasn't In The Sauna And On This Dog Walk I Was Hearing About Somebody In Our Town Who Is On Drugs And They Had They Were Boasting About Extracting Money From A Disabled Lady And They Done That Repeatedly Over A Period Of Time And Can I Just Mention To You We Seek To Love All In This Town Wicke Home Is Connection Seek To Provide Places For People To Stay And To Keep Them In Places Of Safety But There Are People In Our Town Who Are Housed They Beg To Beg To Beg To Feed A Habit Now That Is Not To Say They Don't Need Help But That Is Do Not Give Them Cash Give

Money To Wicke Home's Connection Give Money To Those You Know Who Serving Maybe Buy Them A Cup Of Tea Or Something But Do Not Give Cash I Was Angry When I Heard About That Really Angry That And They Were Bragging To Other Folk Who Were On Drugs As Well So We Need To Stand Against This In Our Town Where Am I Why Am I Going Malcolm Please Keep Me Focused So We Are Overwhelmed As New Testament Believers We Realize We Are Overwhelmed Before We Met Christ By Selfish Desires That Was Just The Way We Were Sin Had Killed Us That Is That Going Too Far David Was Nearly Killed By A Lion And A Bear Sin Has Killed Us Did You Know That Romans Says We Were Dead In Our Trespasses And Sins But God Has Made Us Alive In Christ Sometimes We
