Jesus himself said, Whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall never thirst, but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life.

[1:17] John 4, 14. Jesus is indeed the fountain of life, and what a difference he makes to life. It is abundant life. In Isaiah 12, 3, the Bible speaks of people joyously drawing water from the wells of salvation.

It is a picture of glorious abundance. Life with Jesus is the best. And a prayer. Dear Lord, help me to enjoy more and more of the delights of our salvation.
