[0:00] The 13th of June. Who is on God's guest list? Lord, who may dwell in your sacred tent? Psalm 15, verse 1.

One of the greatest privileges we could ever experience is found in Revelation chapter 3 and verse 20, when Jesus said, Look at me. I stand at the door. I knock.

If you hear me call and open the door, I'll come right in and sit down to supper with you. The message. Imagine that. Jesus comes to eat with us.

Despise the despicable. Keep your word even when it costs you. Make an honest living. Never take a bribe. Psalm 15, verse 2-5 These are the people whom God wants to be in his presence.

They will stand unashamed before him. This is a challenge to us about the kind of people we are. The kind of life we lead. Would God include you in his guest list?

The wonderful thing is that God himself helps us to develop our Christian character so that we become acceptable to him. And a prayer.
