Old Testament teaches us about Jesus, just as the New Testament does. Thirdly, God is praised because he and he only is the one who has the authority to command us to believe on him and obey him. This sums up what Paul has been teaching throughout his letter to the Romans. The gospel, the Bible, and the obedience to God, all coming into our experience through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. And a prayer. To you, O God, be the glory forever. Amen.
