[0:00] The 22nd of May. When God smiles in my soul. Our passage today is from Romans chapter 5 verse 1.

We receive this gift of peace through faith. That is, by accepting the fact that it is Jesus who makes us right in God's sight and not our own efforts to try to make ourselves presentable to God.

One Bible scholar, William Hendrickson, has said that this peace with God is the smile of God reflected in the soul of the believer. That is beautiful.

When God smiles on my soul. This everlasting peace, as certain as his name, is sure as God's eternal throne, unchangeably the same.

Horatius Boner said that. And all because of what Jesus Christ has done for us. And a prayer. Dear Lord, I thank you for that smile of yours in my soul.

It is a precious gift to know that my soul is safe because of what Jesus has done for me. Amen.
