I wonder what he felt like having been so nearly made an apostle. We should spare a thought for him. Sometimes it may be that we are passed over for a promotion, or not chosen for a team, or not appointed to some office in the church.

[1 : 1 5] We can feel hurt when that happens. Maybe we feel angry or jealous of the person who was chosen instead of us. I have no reason to think Joseph felt like that. After all, the other apostles liked him well enough to think he would have been a good apostle.

But in some ways, I do feel sorry for him. And a prayer. Dear Lord, help me to cope with hurts and disappointments, and to see that you have another plan for me. Amen.
