So Jesus had a divine nature and a human nature. These two natures lived, as it were, in perfect harmony in one sinless person, Jesus Christ.

When Jesus was raised from the dead on the third day, after the crucifixion, it was proof of his uniqueness. Charles Wesley put it like this, love divine.

What have you done? The immortal God had died for me. The Father's co-eternal Son bore all my sins upon the tree.
